Designates March 10 of each year as “Mighty Oregon” Day. (Committee vote: Yeas: 8 - Barnhart, Gilliam, Hoyle, Kennemer, McLane, Nosse, Smith Warner, Wilson; Nays: 1 – Rayfield)

<u>HB 2938</u>	RCLUM	dp	04/15/15	Clem
Prohibits city from requiring consent to annexation of landowner’s property in exchange for city providing county service as agent of county. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HOUSE BILLS:

<u>HB 2024-A</u>	HC	dpa PE	04/16/15	Keny-Guyer
Directs the Oregon Health Authority (OHA), in consultation with the coordinated care organizations and dental care organizations, to adopt rules and procedures relating to training and certification of health workers to provide basic preventive dental services to underserved children. Specifies required topics for certification and responsibilities of the health workers. Directs OHA to reimburse the cost of the preventive dental services provided. Establishes July 1, 2016 as the operative date. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2127-A **REV** **dpa PE** **04/16/15** **Davis**

Allows authorized agent providing closing and settlement services in conveyance of real property to tax-exempt government transferee to withhold and pay to county in which property is located, property taxes on the real property as of the date of the conveyance if written instructions to do so are received from transferor. Prohibits county clerk from recording fee title of real property if certificate issued by county assessor does not accompany instrument conveying or contracting to convey fee title. Requires a person, seeking to record an instrument of sale to an exempt government transferee, to pay the tax collector the amount of charges against that real property. If exact amount of charges is not known then person will pay the assessor's estimate. Any deficiency required to be paid constitutes a personal debt and is not a lien on the property and is required to be collected as delinquent personal property. Requires assessor to issue certificate prescribed by the Department of Revenue attesting that all charges against the real property have been paid as of date of recording. Defines terms. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 2282-A **TED** **dpa PE** **04/16/15** **Davis**

Allows Department of Transportation to receive electronically-transmitted documents necessary to do any of the following: issue or transfer vehicle title; register or transfer registration of a vehicle; issue a registration plate; or comply with odometer disclosure requirements. Specifies that, with exceptions, acknowledgement by notary public is not required for such transactions. Authorizes Department to adopt rules necessary to carry out provisions of the measure. Specifies that automobile dealers may charge a purchaser of a vehicle for performing any of the following actions: verifying and clearing titles; perfecting, releasing or satisfying liens or other security interests; complying with federal security requirements; and any other service rendered by the dealer for the purpose of complying with state and federal laws. Limits fees to \$150 if dealer uses an integrator (of which \$25 is entitled to the integrator) and \$115 if the dealer does not use an integrator. (Committee vote: 7-0-0)

HB 2638 **HC** **dp** **04/16/15** **Lively**

Expands the use of the Oregon Prescription Drug Program (OPDP) to include medical assistance recipients and coordinated care organizations. Allows the Oregon Health Authority to deny reimbursement of legend drugs until six months after the United States Food and Drug Administration approval. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2934-A **HC** **dpa PE** **04/16/15** **Keny-Guyer**

Directs Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to convene a stakeholder workgroup. Specifies workgroup membership, when the first meeting shall occur and to develop recommendations to be reported to the interim health care committees no later than December 1, 2015. (Committee vote: Yeas: 7 - Clem, Greenlick, Hayden, Kennemer, Keny-Guyer, Lively, Nosse: Nays: 1 – Buehler: Exc: 1 – Weidner)

HB 2964-A **JUD** **dpa PE** **04/16/15** **Barton**
Includes conservator as person who may file consent form in action for recovery of damages to child by wrongful act. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 2972-A **HC** **dpa PE** **04/16/15** **Hayden
Keny-Guyer**
Directs the State Board of Education, in consultation with the Oregon Health Authority and the Oregon Board of Dentistry, to adopt rules and guidelines for dental screenings. Requires public school students seven years of age or younger, who are beginning educational program, to have dental screening. Defines dental screening. Modifies exemptions to the screening requirement. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 3016-A **HS** **dpa PE** **04/16/15** **Parrish**
Restores capital gains tax exemption for property sales to entities that include tenants, non-profits or housing authorities. Modifies time limit for tenants to form or associate to submit purchase offer. Increases assessment fee and imposes reimbursement to county for processing. Increases mobile home park registration fee. Cancels unpaid taxes and assessment fees. Prohibits mandatory consignment sales. Clarifies rules for competing sales. Applies to tax years beginning January 1, 2015, and before January 1, 2020. Takes effect on 91st day after sine die. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 3139-A **HC** **dpa PE** **04/16/15** **Hayden**
Defines mobile medical clinic. Specifies that health professional be licensed by appropriate licensing board. Establishes criteria for mobile medical clinic be a non-profit and with the permission of the private property owner be located for 180 days or less. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 3168-A **JUD** **dpa PE** **04/16/15** **Bentz**
Authorizes court to waive previously imposed fines if offender completes drug treatment program as condition of supervision. Prohibits court from returning funds to defendant that have already been paid. Authorizes court to enter supplemental judgment modifying court-appointed counsel fees if payment of fees would interfere with offender's ability to pay for drug treatment program. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

Modifies authority of metropolitan service district (METRO) to acquire or construct visitor-oriented facilities. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: Yeas: 5 - Barnhart, Hoyle, Nosse, Rayfield, Smith Warner: Nays: 3 - Kennemer, McLane, Wilson: Exc: 1 - Gilliam)

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
