<u>HB 2601-A</u>	JUD	dpa PE	04/20/15	Smith Warner
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Requires member of law enforcement agency possessing probable cause to believe custodial interference in the first or second degree, or kidnapping in the first or second degree, involving a child has occurred to notify Oregon State Police Missing Children Clearinghouse within 24 hours. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

<u>HB 2231-A</u>	HC	dpa PE	04/22/15	Nathanson
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Directs Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to adopt rule standards for determining whether information requested by a coordinate care organization from an organizational provider is redundant with respect to the reporting requirements for an assessment or if the information is outside of the scope of the assessment criteria. Directs OHA to develop and maintain centralized database for the credentialing of behavioral health care organization providers and adopt rules relating to the content and operations of the database. Directs OHA to utilize the current committee (ORS 430.637) to facilitate the rule making process. Specifies criteria for the rules. Directs the committee to report to the Legislative Assembly on the database effectiveness no later than December 31, 2015. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

<u>HB 2314-A</u>	JUD	dpa PE	04/22/15	Olson
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Allows youth offender foster homes to be maintained by persons related to youth offender by blood or marriage under circumstances set forth in rule by Oregon Youth Authority. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 2466-A **HC** **dpa PE** **04/22/15** **Greenlick**
Aligns Oregon statutes with the Affordable Care Act (ACA) for compliance relating to health benefit plans. Specifies that coordination of benefit requirements apply to all group plans. Adds provisions allowing exemptions from some requirements of the ACA for transitional large employer health benefit plans and transitional grandfathered large employer health benefit plans. Allows director, by rule, to extend operative provisions related to transitional large employer health benefit plans. Clarifies requirements and applicability of requirements to actively market a group health benefit plan. Allows the director of Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) to specify criteria for small employer for purposes of determining eligibility for small or large employer health benefit plan. Makes the following technical changes necessary to conform with ACA: catastrophic plans must be offered in and out of exchange; removes references to credible coverage; changes language relating to waiting periods and exclusionary periods to conform with federal requirements; clarifies that preexisting conditions can still be imposed on grandfathered individual or transitional health benefit plan, but not group plans and removes a reporting provision. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 2693 **JUD** **dp** **04/22/15** **Gomberg**
Creates crime of encouraging sexual assault of an animal carrying maximum penalty of one year imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both. Raises classification of crime of sexual assault of an animal from Class A misdemeanor to Class C felony and punishes by maximum of five years imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both. Increases length of time person convicted of sexual assault of an animal is prohibited from possessing certain animals from five to fifteen years. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

HB 2876-A **HC** **dpa PE** **04/22/15** **Buehler**
Prohibits health care facilities from allowing a person without specified qualifications and education to practice surgical technology. Specifies continuing education requirements. Provides an exception for health care facilities in rural or medically underserved areas of the state. Directs the Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules necessary to carry out provisions of the bill relating to surgical technology. Clarifies operative date for rural or medically underserved facilities as July 1, 2017. Sets July 1, 2016 as operative date. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 3069-A **ED** **dpa PE** **04/22/15** **Johnson**
Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC) to adopt rules to require students in education programs to be able to instruct pupils to meet or exceed third-grade reading standards by the end of third grade. Mandates that any education program unable to plan to meet requirements under rule within one year report to TSPC. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

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HB 3149 **HC** **dp** **04/22/15** **McLane**
Provides a registered nurse who is employed by a public or private school to accept orders from a licensed physician or osteopath in other state or U.S. territory if the order is related to treatment of a student who has been enrolled at the school for not more than 90 days. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 3319-A **ED** **dpa PE** **04/22/15** **Taylor**
Requires school districts to report to Oregon Department of Education (ODE) on strategies and activities used to increase high school graduation rates or reduce chronic absenteeism. Requires ODE to report to Legislative Assembly each even-numbered year. Describes manner of report. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: Yeas: 5 - Doherty, Frederick, McLain, Piluso, Reardon; Nays: 4 - Barreto, Hack, Sprenger, Wilson)
Please note: Has minimal fiscal impact, no statement issued.

HB 3464-A **HC** **dpa PE** **04/22/15** **Keny-Guyer**
Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to adopt rules regarding time frames within which a pregnant medical assistance recipient needs general or specialty dental care. Specifies services to be covered, deadlines and that fee-for-service time frame are to be the same. Directs OHA to report to the Legislative Assembly no later than December 1, 2016. Establishes January 1, 2016 as the operative date. (Committee vote: 8-0-1)

HB 3468 **JUD** **dp** **04/22/15** **Williamson**
Adds threatening to cause physical injury to animal to induce other person to engage in certain conduct as conduct constituting crime of coercion. (Committee vote: 9-0-0)

SB 927 **RULES** **dp** **04/14/15** **Smith Warner**
Modifies authority of metropolitan service district (METRO) to acquire or construct visitor-oriented facilities. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee vote: Yeas: 5 - Barnhart, Hoyle, Nosse, Rayfield, Smith Warner; Nays: 3 - Kennemer, McLane, Wilson; Exc: 1 – Gilliam)
