Urges Congress to fund and maintain United States Coast Guard Air Facility at Newport, Oregon, in perpetuity. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --McLane)

HJR 31 **HRULES** **A** **5/13/2015** **Hack, Hoyle**
Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to vest power of impeachment of statewide elected Executive Branch officials in House of Representatives and power to try impeachments in Senate. Requires three-fifths majority vote of House of Representatives to deliver impeachment resolution to Senate and two-thirds majority vote of Senate for conviction. Limits judgment to removal from office and disqualification from holding other public office. Refers proposed amendment to people for approval or rejection at next regular general election held throughout this state. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Nay, 2 --Gilliam, Smith Warner; Exc., 1 --McLane)

Urges Congress to pass legislation to better align 42 C.F.R. Part 2 with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 by allowing health care providers to share patient's treatment information while maintaining protections against disclosure and discrimination. Declares legislation would allow states to maintain strong confidentiality protections, deliver coordinated care, and administer electronic health records. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

SB 28 A-Eng. **HRULES** **dp** **5/4/2015** **Barnhart**
Clarifies that county clerk may use voter's registration record, rather than physical registration card to authenticate signatures. Permits elections official to deliver form updating information on district board members by best form of communication. Clarifies that filing officer is responsible for release as public record, information regarding challenged ballot. Filing officer for purpose of release of information is Secretary of State for federal, statewide and state senator and representative elections, and county clerk for county, city or district elections. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5; Nay, 4 --McLane, Gilliam, Kennemer, Wilson)

SB 363 A-Eng. **HJUD** **dp** **5/4/2015** **Greenlick**
Prohibits prosecuting attorney from charging defendant fee for performing duties associated with

SB 590 **HJUD** **dp** **5/4/2015** **Krieger**

Requires court to appoint court visitor in guardianship proceeding for minor respondent who is more than 16 years of age and for whom guardianship petition is likely to be filed as respondent reaches age of majority. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

SB 622 A-Eng. **HJUD** **dp** **5/4/2015** **Barton**

Adds home care workers and personal support workers to list of mandatory reporters of abuse. Specifies Legislative Assembly members are mandatory reporters of abuse of residents of long-term care facilities and abuse of adults with developmental disabilities or mental illness. Extends criminal liability protection to those who make reports in good faith. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

SB 219 **HHEDIW** **dp** **5/5/2015** **Williamson**

Directs appropriations for public universities and Oregon Health and Science University (OHSU) to Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) rather than Department of Administrative Services. Requires majority approval of HECC members for official action. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 240 **HHEDIW** **dp** **5/5/2015** **Johnson**

Authorizes State Apprenticeship and Training Council to make exceptions to apprentice wage schedule, journeyworker hourly wage rate or minimum ratio of journeyworkers to apprentices to accommodate Oregon Youth Authority (OYA) training programs and apprenticeships. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

Permits individual enrolled in alternative education program to be considered out-of-school youth for purposes of federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 7 A-Eng. **HCPGE** **dp** **5/6/2015** **Rayfield**

Requires Department of Administrative Services to procure or supervise procurement of information technology goods and services for Oregon Health Authority. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7)

SB 133 A-Eng. **HBL** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Kennemer**
 Authorizes the Department of Business and Consumer Services to develop system that provides electronic access to building codes information available to public bodies that provide construction-related services. Prohibits Department from taking disciplinary action against public body that chooses not to participate in the system. Eliminates January 2, 2018, sunset on building permit surcharge used to defray cost of developing and administering electronic building codes information system. Reduces surcharge from five percent of permit fees to four percent.

SB 185 A-Eng. **HBL** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Doherty**
 Establishes unlawful employment practice of requiring employee or job applicant to establish or maintain a personal social media account or to authorize employer to advertise on personal social media account of employee or applicant. (Committee Vote: Aye, 10; Exc., 1 --Fagan)

SB 286 **HBL** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Doherty**
 Increases maximum civil penalties from \$10,000 to \$200,000 per event per day and raises the maximum penalty for a series of failures from \$500,000 to \$2,000,000, for violating statutes that provide for regulation of hazardous substance by Public Utility Commission. Clarifies process for imposing civil penalty and regarding where collected moneys are to be deposited. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Nay, 2 --Heard, Weidner; Exc., 1 --Fagan)

SB 291 A-Eng. **HBL** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Holvey**
 Modifies circumstances under which injured state worker has right to reinstatement or reemployment. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Nay, 4 --Barreto, Esquivel, Heard, Weidner; Exc., 1 --Fagan)

SB 295 A-Eng. **HED** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Taylor**
 Requires Chief Education Officer, members of Oregon Education Investment Board (OEIB), and auditor of metropolitan service districts to file verified statements of economic interest.

SB 321 A-Eng. **HED** **dp** **5/7/2015** **McLain**
 Decreases compulsory school age from seven to six years of age. Takes effect July 1, 2016.

SB 496 **HBL** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Doherty**

Clarifies that death or permanent total disability that is a compensable workers' compensation claim is a qualifying criteria for eligibility for benefits from the Public Safety Memorial Fund. (Committee Vote: Aye, 10; Exc., 1 --Fagan)

SB 553 A-Eng. **HED** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Piluso**

Imposes limits on instances when student in fifth grade or lower may be subjected to out-of-school suspension or expulsion from school. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Nay, 2 --Barreto, Hack)

SB 556 **HED** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Sprenger**

Prohibits use of expulsion to address truancy. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Nay, 1 --Barreto)

SB 693 A-Eng. **HBL** **dp** **5/7/2015** **Barton**

Authorizes scrap metal business to make payment by electronic funds transfer, stored value card, or stored value device. (Committee Vote: Aye, 10; Exc., 1 --Fagan)

SB 141 A-Eng. **HBL** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Nosse**

Creates provisions for persons appointed to operate a store established by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to receive payments of four percent of the average annual sales from the previous five years if, and only if, the system for selling containers of distilled liquor at retail in this state changes after the person assumed operation of the store. Creates provisions to fund business loss compensation from proceeds from selling the assets of the Commission. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 11)

SB 199 A-Eng. **HJUD** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Krieger**

Requires Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to notify victim prior to certain release determinations if the victim requests notification. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

SB 225 A-Eng. **HHS** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Taylor**

Allows Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to notify benefit recipients of suspensions or closures of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and The Special

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Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC), through news media, information at sites recipients frequent, and general mailings to recipients' households. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Evans, Parrish)

SB 287 **HED** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Hack**

Deletes provision that authorizes teachers who are licensed and properly endorsed by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to practice speech-language pathology without obtaining license from State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology. Becomes operative July 1, 2016. Creates grandfather clause for teachers who are licensed and properly endorsed before July 1, 2016. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 350 A-Eng. **HJUD** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Lininger**

Authorizes judicial districts with populations between 100,000 and 200,000 to elect which set of timelines apply to motion to disqualify judge. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Sprenger, Williamson)

SB 377 B-Eng. **HJUD** **dpa PE** **5/11/2015** **Barton**

Modifies "Computer Crime" statute to specifically include "theft of an intimate image" as prohibited conduct. Amends ORS 137.540 by re-ordering the general conditions of probation. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. **House Amendment Adds technical re-ordering of the general conditions of probation so that the chronological order is symmetrical with the general conditions of post-prison supervision as it was prior to HB 3194 from the 2013 legislative session.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

SB 588 **HED** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Barreto**

Allows school district and public charter school to be considered single legal entity for purpose of public charter school law if public charter school is only school in school district and other conditions are met. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 839 A-Eng. **HJUD** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Fagan, Williamson**

Immunizes person from arrest or prosecution for certain drug offenses when evidence obtained in response to request for medical assistance. Prohibits law enforcement from arresting person for violating supervision when evidence obtained is in response to request for medical assistance. Prohibits law enforcement from arresting person on certain Oregon warrants when person discovered after request for medical assistance. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

 Authorizes Department of State Police to enter into lease agreements and take title to real property. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Barton, Lininger)

- SB 368 A-Eng.** **HJUD** **dp** **5/12/2015** **Williamson**
 Clarifies that writ of execution for foreclosure suit is not required to include money award in all circumstances. Requires inclusion of declaration of amount of debt lien secures, and if plaintiff requests in complaint, money award against lien debtor. Provides clarifying language to distinguish between in rem (action taken directly against property, not the title of individual claimants) and real property. Requires sheriff to deliver proceeds from execution sale to court administrator. Permits judgment creditor in foreclosure to bid on foreclosed property at execution sale or ahead of time in writing with certain requirements. Mandates judgment creditor's bid may not exceed full amount owing on money award if judgment includes money award or amount declared in judgment when no money award is included. Applies to foreclosure suits commencing or pending on or after effective date. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Barton, Lininger)

 Defines "boarding kennel" and includes definition under exemption for "keeper." Provides license fee exemption for animals considered "inventory." (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Barton, Lininger)

- SB 121 A-Eng.** **HHC** **dp** **5/13/2015** **Smith, Weidner**
 Authorizes electors in affected territory to propose plan for abating health hazard other than annexation of territory or extraterritorial extension of city or district services to territory. Requires cost effectiveness as criteria to consider by Oregon Health Authority (OHA) or Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) with respect to alternative plan proposed in resolution. Requires 40 percent of residents to petition local board of health to initiate annexation proceedings to abate health hazard. Permits withdrawal of petition if a specified number of petitioners provide local

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board of health with alternative plan. Requires, if petition is withdrawn before OHA finds danger to public health exists, all proceedings be terminated. Requires, if petition is withdrawn after a danger to public health exists, alternative plan be evaluated. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

SB 144 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/13/2015** **Buehler**

Modifies definition of health benefit plan to include self-insured health plan offered through the Public Employees' Benefit Board or the Oregon Educators Benefit Board. Modifies health professional definition. Requires health benefit plan to provide coverage of a health service using synchronous two-way interactive video conferencing if it is safely and effectively being provided according to the accepted health care practices. Requires the technology being used meets all the state and federal privacy and security laws. Eliminates requirement that plan provide coverage if health service does not duplicate or supplant a health service available to patient in person; and deletes the originating sites requirement. Establishes that telemedicine coverage is subject to the reimbursement specified in the contract between the plan and healthcare professional. Applies to plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2016. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

SB 148 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/13/2015** **Clem**

Increases the Board of Pharmacy membership from seven to nine members. Adds licensed pharmacy technicians to the new membership positions. Requires the licensed pharmacy technicians to be in good standing, engaged in duties, and have three years of experience. Directs the Governor to appoint the licensed pharmacy technicians for terms beginning on January 1, 2016. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

SB 188 B-Eng. **HJUD** **dpa PE** **5/13/2015** **Williamson**

Creates crime of unlawful dissemination of an intimate image. Prohibits the nonconsensual disclosure of an intimate picture to a website with a specific intent to harass, humiliate, or injure another person. Establishes that the first violation is a Class A misdemeanor, with each subsequent violation being a Class C felony. Defines terms. Defines exceptions, including immunity for interactive computer services as they are defined by the Federal Communication Decency Act. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. **House Amendment Adds an emergency clause. Defines immunity given to interactive computer services so that it mirrors the immunity given by the Federal Communications Decency Act.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 249 A-Eng. **HEE** **dp** **5/13/2015** **Vega Pederson**

Allows payments for off-site compensatory mitigation credits to Oregon Removal-Fill Mitigation Fund (Fund) when credits from approved mitigation bank were not available in region at time first payment was made to Fund and expenses associated with Department of State Lands (DSL) mitigation bank project in region have not been fully recovered by DSL. Declares emergency,

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effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 364 A-Eng. **HJUD** **dp** **5/13/2015** **Lininger**

Requires court to consider current classification of marijuana offense in order to determine whether a conviction is eligible to be set aside. Reinstates former provision of ORS 161.705 that permits marijuana possession offenses to be reduced to misdemeanors. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

Requires Oregon Health Authority to develop a plan for communication among local mental health authorities and local systems to improve notification and information sharing when a death that is suspected to be a suicide of an individual who is 24 years of age or younger. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

Expands the duties of the Central Oregon Health Council (Council). Increases Council membership from eleven to fifteen. Specifies members will be reappointed. Clarifies regional health improvement plan is to include community health assessment and community health improvement plan. Adjusts report date to Legislative Assembly. Sets sunset to 2022. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

(Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

 Repeals requirement for business to file with the Secretary of State (SOS) a notice of intent to conduct going-out-of-business sale. Merges requirements dealing with registration, recording and fees for union labels and fraternal insignia with requirements for trademarks. Repeals provision relating to filing credentials of member of consular corps with SOS. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 10; Nay, 1 --Weidner)
