 Reorganizes mission and governance of State Library. Changes name of Trustees of State Library to State Library Board, changes composition and number of board members, and provides for Governor rather than Trustees of State Library to appoint State Librarian. Establishes State Reference Coordinating Council consisting of State Librarian, State Archivist and State of Oregon Law Librarian to coordinate interagency delivery of services between state agencies and ensure collaboration. Provides for State Library to approve selection, purchase and maintenance of reference databases and subscriptions for state agencies other than databases, services and resources provided by State Archives and State of Oregon Law Library.  Creates provisions for persons appointed to operate a store established by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to receive payments of four percent of the average annual sales from the previous five years if, and only if, the system for selling containers of distilled liquor at retail in this

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state changes after the person assumed operation of the store. Creates provisions to fund business loss compensation from proceeds from selling the assets of the Commission. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 11)

Requires Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to notify victim prior to certain release determinations if the victim requests notification. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

SB 225 A-Eng. **HHS** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Taylor**

Allows Department of Human Services and Oregon Health Authority to notify benefit recipients of suspensions or closures of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) and The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC), through news media, information at sites recipients frequent, and general mailings to recipients' households. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Evans, Parrish)

SB 287 **HED** **dp** **5/11/2015** **Hack**

Deletes provision that authorizes teachers who are licensed and properly endorsed by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to practice speech-language pathology without obtaining license from State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology. Becomes operative July 1, 2016. Creates grandfather clause for teachers who are licensed and properly endorsed before July 1, 2016. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

Authorizes judicial districts with populations between 100,000 and 200,000 to elect which set of timelines apply to motion to disqualify judge. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Sprenger, Williamson)

Modifies "Computer Crime" statute to specifically include "theft of an intimate image" as prohibited conduct. Amends ORS 137.540 by re-ordering the general conditions of probation. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. **House Amendment Adds technical re-ordering of the general conditions of probation so that the chronological order is symmetrical with the general conditions of post-prison supervision as it was prior to HB 3194 from the 2013 legislative session.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

- SB 368 A-Eng.** **HJUD** **dp** **5/12/2015** **Williamson**
 Clarifies that writ of execution for foreclosure suit is not required to include money award in all circumstances. Requires inclusion of declaration of amount of debt lien secures, and if plaintiff requests in complaint, money award against lien debtor. Provides clarifying language to distinguish between in rem (action taken directly against property, not the title of individual claimants) and real property. Requires sheriff to deliver proceeds from execution sale to court administrator. Permits judgment creditor in foreclosure to bid on foreclosed property at execution sale or ahead of time in writing with certain requirements. Mandates judgment creditor's bid may not exceed full amount owing on money award if judgment includes money award or amount declared in judgment when no money award is included. Applies to foreclosure suits commencing or pending on or after effective date. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Barton, Lininger)

Defines "boarding kennel" and includes definition under exemption for "keeper." Provides license fee exemption for animals considered "inventory." (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Barton, Liningier)

SB 121 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/13/2015** **Smith, Weidner**

Authorizes electors in affected territory to propose plan for abating health hazard other than annexation of territory or extraterritorial extension of city or district services to territory. Requires cost effectiveness as criteria to consider by Oregon Health Authority (OHA) or Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) with respect to alternative plan proposed in resolution. Requires 40 percent of residents to petition local board of health to initiate annexation proceedings to abate health hazard. Permits withdrawal of petition if a specified number of petitioners provide local board of health with alternative plan. Requires, if petition is withdrawn before OHA finds danger to public health exists, all proceedings be terminated. Requires, if petition is withdrawn after a danger to public health exists, alternative plan be evaluated. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

SB 144 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/13/2015** **Buehler**

Modifies definition of health benefit plan to include self-insured health plan offered through the Public Employees' Benefit Board or the Oregon Educators Benefit Board. Modifies health professional definition. Requires health benefit plan to provide coverage of a health service using synchronous two-way interactive video conferencing if it is safely and effectively being provided according to the accepted health care practices. Requires the technology being used meets all the state and federal privacy and security laws. Eliminates requirement that plan provide coverage if health service does not duplicate or supplant a health service available to patient in person; and deletes the originating sites requirement. Establishes that telemedicine coverage is subject to the reimbursement specified in the contract between the plan and healthcare professional. Applies to plans issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2016. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

SB 148 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/13/2015** **Clem**

Increases the Board of Pharmacy membership from seven to nine members. Adds licensed pharmacy technicians to the new membership positions. Requires the licensed pharmacy technicians to be in good standing, engaged in duties, and have three years of experience. Directs the Governor to appoint the licensed pharmacy technicians for terms beginning on January 1, 2016. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

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- SB 188 B-Eng.** **HJUD** **dpa PE** **5/13/2015** **Williamson**
Creates crime of unlawful dissemination of an intimate image. Prohibits the nonconsensual disclosure of an intimate picture to a website with a specific intent to harass, humiliate, or injure another person. Establishes that the first violation is a Class A misdemeanor, with each subsequent violation being a Class C felony. Defines terms. Defines exceptions, including immunity for interactive computer services as they are defined by the Federal Communication Decency Act. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. **House Amendment Adds an emergency clause. Defines immunity given to interactive computer services so that it mirrors the immunity given by the Federal Communications Decency Act.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

Allows payments for off-site compensatory mitigation credits to Oregon Removal-Fill Mitigation Fund (Fund) when credits from approved mitigation bank were not available in region at time first payment was made to Fund and expenses associated with Department of State Lands (DSL) mitigation bank project in region have not been fully recovered by DSL. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

Requires court to consider current classification of marijuana offense in order to determine whether a conviction is eligible to be set aside. Clarifies efficiency standards apply to battery backups and uninterruptible power supplies for small battery charger systems not sold at retail manufactured on or after January 1, 2017. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 76 **HBL** **dp** **5/15/2015** **Nosse**

Repeals requirement for business to file with the Secretary of State (SOS) a notice of intent to conduct going-out-of-business sale. Requires businesses to self-generate and post the notice that they currently file with SOS. Merges requirements dealing with registration, recording and

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fees for union labels and fraternal insignia with requirements for trademarks. Repeals provision relating to filing credentials of member of consular corps with SOS. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 10; Nay, 1 --Weidner)

Requires school district to provide instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and use of automated external defibrillators (AEDs). Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

SB 83 A-Eng. **HED** **dp** **5/14/2015** **Piluso**

Establishes supervised clinical practice experience requirements for applicants for initial teaching license. First applies to 2020-21 school year. Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC) to convene work group to assist with implementation of requirements. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Hack)

Requires public universities, community colleges and Oregon-based private universities and colleges to adopt written protocols for responding to sexual assault involving student, faculty or staff. Protocols are to be posted on institutional website and distributed to students at orientation. Requires protocols ensure that victims who report sexual assault are provided with written notification containing information on their rights, legal options, campus-based services and state- and community-based resources. **House Amendment Expands applicability beyond university facilities to apply in all cases involving students, faculty and staff of the institution regardless of location of the assault. Adds requirement that written protocol be made available to students during orientation and on university website.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --McKeown)

Clarifies insurance reimbursement of primary care or mental health services by physician assistants and certified nurse practitioners in independent practice. Requires use of national provider identifier of the physician assistant, nurse practitioner or facility in which physician assistant or nurse practitioner provides services. **House Amendment Provides additional reimbursement criteria for nurse practitioners and physician assistants.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

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epidemiological causes of and risk factors associated with trauma injuries. Establishes that individually identifiable information may be released to Department of Human Services to plan and provide services to individuals adversely affected by trauma injuries. Requires members of the Consumer Advisory Council, who advise the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Director on provisions of mental health services, to be compensated by OHA for performing duties of the council. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

SB 230 B-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **5/18/2015** **Nosse**

Specifies and requires healthcare workers to submit demographic, education and other information to the healthcare workforce regulatory boards. Specifies that an individual submit the information when renewing a license with the board. Transfers the maintaining of the information from the Oregon Office for Health Policy and Research to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). Directs OHA to collaborate with each board to adopt rules on demographics and other information. Clarifies when board may release personally identifiable information to OHA. Requires OHA to use collected information from the healthcare workforce database. Establishes that database includes data on state healthcare workforce diversity, and that OHA can contract with private entity to maintain and analyze data. Adds training to the list of information to be submitted. Removes the agency's exemption status from public contracting code. Sets January 1, 2016 as operative date. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Removes the agency's exemption status from public contracting code.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Keny-Guyer)

SB 234 **HJUD** **dp** **5/18/2015** **Williamson**

Repeals statutory requirement that Department of Corrections and certain state agencies jointly and annually promulgate rules for purchasing products manufactured by Oregon Corrections Enterprises. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Exc., 2 --Krieger, Lininger)

SB 280 B-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **5/18/2015** **Buehler**

Changes Board of Medical Imaging (Board) twelve-member composition. Specifies one must be licensed physician who is radiologist and in "good standing." Specifies three must be licensed physicians in "good standing" and five must be "actively engaged" medical imaging licensees. Requires that if the Board cannot fill physician spots, the Governor may appoint any combination of the following: a chiropractic physician certified by the American Chiropractic Board of Radiology; an actively engaged medical imaging licensee; a limited X-ray machine operator and a member of the public. Allows Governor to appoint retired physician to the Board if he/she has not been retired for more than six years; they are registered with the Oregon Medical Board (OMB) as retired emeritus physician; or who has notified the OMB of retirement and is in good standing. Defines "actively engaged." Declares emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment**

SB 379 B-Eng. **HJUD** **dpa PE** **5/18/2015** **Barton**

Updates probate statutes relating to wills and intestate estates. Creates process for introducing writing as will, revocation of will, or addition to will when execution requirements are not met if writing establishes intention by clear and convincing evidence and certain procedural requirements are met. Creates avenue for inheritance for child conceived posthumously when decedent's will or trust provides for posthumous conception, written permission for use of genetic material is given prior to death, and child is in utero within two years of decedent's death. Allows continuation of wills executed by domestic partners should such partners later marry. Defines "generation" as a group of humans that constitute a single step in a line of descent from an ancestor. Replaces "degrees of kinship" language with "generation" descriptions. Allows express limitation or exclusion of individual or class within will. Specifies that termination of parental rights is included as forfeiture of share by parent. Requires diligent search and inquiry prior to property escheating to state. Clarifies statute on rights of child adopted after domestic partners marry. Requires signatures of witness to will to hear or observe testator direct another to sign will, and sign the will within a reasonable time before testator's death. Allows contemporaneously executed affidavits to be counted as signatures. Prohibits electronic documents as formal will. Allows digital statement or list disposing of household items, furniture, furnishings, and personal effects. Prohibits disposal of money, business property, or certificates of title through digital writing. Clarifies statutes on enforcement of no-contest clauses, partial revocation of will, and inheritance under slayer or abuser statutes. **House Amendment Clarifies provisions for inheritance by posthumously conceived child.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

Makes minor changes to ORS 419A.255 to correct unintended consequences of recent legislative changes. Clarifies that nothing in current law prohibits juvenile court from providing certain information to appropriate Child Support Program Administrator. Proposes one-year extension to operative date of statutory provisions regarding providing access to juvenile court records to other persons not specifically provided access by statute.
