Reallocates moneys between transportation projects funded by the Jobs and Transportation Act of 2009. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 3 --Bentz, Davis, Hack)

SB 601 A-Eng. **HJUD** **dp** **5/20/2015** **Greenlick**

Updates Oregon Consumer Identity Theft Protection Act. Requires notification to Attorney General of breach of security that affects more than 250 consumers. Makes violation of Act unlawful trade practice enforceable by prosecuting attorney. Expands definition of "personal information" to include data from automatic measurements of physical characteristics, health insurance policy numbers in combination with other unique identifiers, and any information about consumers' mental or physical health, medical history, or diagnosis or treatment. Expands use of last four digits of certain numbers to include passport number, financial account number, and credit card number. Exempts entities covered by Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) when copy of notice sent to consumers or federal regulators is also sent to Attorney General. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

Includes intergovernmental entities in definition of "local government" for purpose of benefit plans offered by Public Employees' Benefit Board. (Committee Vote: Aye, 11)

SB 919 **HJUD** **dp** **5/20/2015** **Barton**

Amends Disorderly Conduct statute. Elevates offense classification for those who falsely report hazardous substance, fire, explosion, catastrophe, or other emergency in all public buildings and court facilities to a Class A Misdemeanor for first offense, to a Class C Felony for each subsequent offense. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Sprenger)

SB 224 **HCPGE** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Nearman**

Exempts Oregon Health Authority and Department of Human Services from certain provisions relating to acquiring, holding or disposing of real property or equitable interest in real property or in mineral or geothermal resource right. Becomes operative January 1, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5; Nay, 1 --Stark; Exc., 1 --Buehler)

SB 278 B-Eng. **HCPGE** **dpa PE** **5/21/2015** **Holvey**

Voids payday loans, title loans and consumer finance loans of \$50,000 or less if, at the time the loan in question is made, the person making the loan was not licensed to issue the loan. Prohibits unlicensed persons, or their successors, assignees or affiliates, from collecting, receiving or retaining principal, interest, fees, or charges related to, or in connection with, payday loans, title

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loans or consumer finance loans of \$50,000 or less. Applies to loans originated on or after measure's effective date. Becomes operative 91 days after measure's effective date. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Deletes provision making measure retroactive to loans originated before effective date of measure.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 5; Nay, 1 --Stark; Exc., 1 --Buehler)

SB 282 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Greenlick**

Prohibits individual from using title "nurse" unless the individual holds a nursing degree or certificate and is licensed to practice the profession in which the degree or certificate was earned. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Abs., 1 --Clem)

SB 284 **HHC** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Kennemer**

Prohibits an individual from using the title "Certified Nursing Assistant," "nursing assistant" or "nurse aide" or abbreviation "CNA" unless the individual is certified by Oregon State Board of Nursing and meets certain other criteria. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Abs., 1 --Clem)

SB 285 **HHC** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Hayden**

Prohibits an individual from using the title "medication aide" or "Certified Medication Aide" or abbreviation "CMA" unless the individual is a certified nursing assistant and meets certain criteria established by the Oregon State Board of Nursing. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Abs., 1 --Clem)

SB 296 A-Eng. **HHS** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Piluso**

Transfers administration and funding structure for Elderly Rental Assistance program from Department of Revenue to Oregon Housing and Community Services. Prescribes operative dates. Takes effect 91st day after sine die. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 385 A-Eng. **HJUD** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Olson**

Adds justice court, municipal court, probate court and juvenile court to definition of "court facility" where firearms and other weapons are prohibited absent specific circumstances. Establishes that prohibited knives include pocketknives. Authorizes municipal, probate, juvenile and justice court judges to establish procedures regulating possession of firearms and other weapons in court facilities. Establishes that in shared court facility, order, policy or procedure of presiding court judge takes precedence over that of municipal court judge, probate court judge, juvenile court judge or justice of the peace. Establishes that conviction under section is Class C felony.

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Clarifies that court may only prohibit weapons in area where court conducts business and during hours court operates. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Nay, 1 --Post; Exc., 2 --Krieger, Sprenger)

SB 390 A-Eng. **HHS** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Piluso, Stark**

Clarifies and defines terms associated with statutes outlining tenant and landlord relations. Specifies new permissible fees, including those for pet waste clean-up. Clarifies definition of "rent" in relationship to housing assistance payments. Prohibits tenant from removing, obstructing or tampering with sprinkler head used for fire suppression. Clarifies process for fee assessments and applications by landlord. Grants fee exception for landlord and tenant from certain provisions. Requires landlord to provide emergency exit routes; outlines recourse. Lists circumstances where tenant not responsible for damage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 440 B-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **5/21/2015** **Buehler**

Requires the Oregon Health Policy Board to develop a strategic plan for collection and use of healthcare data and to establish the Health Plan Quality Metrics Committee (Committee). Directs the Committee to develop health outcomes and quality measures for the coordinated care organizations (CCOs) and plans offered by the Public Employees' Benefit Board and the Oregon Educators Benefit Board and to publish the data. Requires the Oregon Health Authority to give CCOs a three-month advance notice before changing health outcomes and quality measures in their contracts. Eliminates the metrics and scoring committee. Grants exclusive authority for Governor to appoint members of the Health Plan Quality Metrics Committee. Further identifies specific membership composition. Adds Oregon Health Authority to work in collaboration with the committee. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Grants exclusive authority for Governor to appoint members of the Health Plan Quality Metrics Committee. Further identifies specific membership composition. Adds Oregon Health Authority to work in collaboration with the Committee.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 7; Nay, 1 --Weidner; Abs., 1 --Clem)

SB 547 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Nosse**

Permits Oregon State Board of Nursing (Board) to issue nurse emeritus license to certified registered nurse anesthetists, certified registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, nurse practitioners or clinical nurse specialists who have been granted retired status by Board. Permits licensees to engage in nursing on voluntary or non-compensatory basis. Requires Board to establish rules for annual license fee and method to determine competency required to practice nursing. Establishes that Board may take action prior to the January 1, 2016 operative date. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Abs., 1 --Clem)

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SB 594 **HHC** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Lively**

Specifies that healthcare practitioner is not required to submit credentialing information to Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and submission is not condition of authorization to practice until OHA has established an operational electronic system. Directs OHA to consult with advisory workgroup about date. Requires notice of rule to be provided to advisory workgroup and healthcare regulatory boards at least six months before effective date. Extends date for OHA to report on implementation of electronic system to interim committees of Legislative Assembly to October 2016, and to Legislative Assembly on or before February 2016. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Abs., 1 --Clem)

SB 659 A-Eng. **HHS** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Gallegos**

Directs Department of Human Services (DHS) to assist families with a child who qualifies for home and community-based assistance in child's state of residence, who spends at least six weeks each year with parent who resides in Oregon, by sharing lists of community providers, contacting Medicaid in the child's state of residence, and providing documentation. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 710 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Keny-Guyer**

Requires specified entities to provide, upon request, one copy of individually identifiable health information free of charge to individual, or to personal representative when the individual is appealing denial of Social Security Disability benefits. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Abs., 1 --Clem)

SB 840 B-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **5/21/2015** **Lively**

Authorizes licensed independent practitioner to initiate or approve prehearing detention in hospital or nonhospital facility of person who is subject of civil commitment proceedings. Defines and standardizes "licensed independent practitioner." **House Amendment Standardizes references to be consistent with licensed independent practitioner.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Abs., 1 --Clem)

SB 864 A-Eng. **HREV** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Bentz, Whitsett**

Clarifies the definition of real property to include in-state property for the purpose of finding the ratio of natural resource property to in-state property value when computing and considering the natural resource credit against the estate tax. Applies to tax years 2015 and beyond. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

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SB 908 B-Eng. **HJUD** **dpa PE** **5/21/2015** **Olson**

Modifies expungement statute. Prohibits offenders from seeking expungement for ten years if probationary sentence was revoked for non-compliance. Prohibits expungement of Assault 3 if victim was under 10 years of age at time of offense. Adds Class B felony possession of controlled substance offenses to list of expungable offenses. Allows one non-motor vehicle violation without re-tolling expungement period. Eliminates repetitive and duplicative language. **House Amendment Replaces "traffic violation" with "motor vehicle violation" to be consistent with original statute.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Nay, 1 --Sprenger)

SB 951 **HHS** **dp** **5/21/2015** **Keny-Guyer**

Modifies charge, size, composition, and duties of Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission (Commission). Makes composition discretionary. Removes ex officio members. Permits Commission to appoint nonmembers to subcommittees. Removes requirement and functions of budget advisory committee. Requires Commission make specific recommendations as part of its long-term strategic plan. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Nay, 1 --Parrish)

SB 267 A-Eng. **HRCLUW** **dp, CC** **5/21/2015** **Post**

Requires Water Resources Department (Department) to report to Eighty-first Legislative Assembly, no later than January 31, 2021, on pilot program allowing specified irrigation districts and water control districts to temporarily transfer water use to another location within district. Specifies water transferred under pilot project can only be used for irrigation. If any of specified districts are unable to participate, requires Department to publish notice of planned participation of another district in weekly notice and allow at least 20 days for public comment. Requires Department to annually publish notice of districts intending to use pilot project prior to commencement of irrigation season. Extends duration of pilot program from June 30, 2016 to January 2, 2022. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7)

SB 319 A-Eng. **HEE** **dp** **5/22/2015** **Boone**

Requires proprietary authorization from Department of State Lands (DSL) to construct or operate ocean renewable energy facility in Oregon's territorial sea. Requires Director of DSL (Director) to adopt rules necessary to implement proprietary authorization program for ocean renewable energy facilities, including requirements for construction and operation; maximum period proprietary authorization could be issued; and provisions to coordinate with issuance of removal or fill permit. Authorizes Director to adopt by rule certain fees. Requires permit for removal or fill activities in territorial sea related to ocean renewable energy facility. Requires DSL to coordinate issuance of proprietary authorization decision and removal or fill permit decision for ocean renewable energy facility. Imposes civil penalties for violation of authorization requirements. Requires DSL to convene committee to assist evaluation of whether to establish general permit or general authorization for removal/fill permits for ocean renewable energy facilities used as components of research projects or demonstration projects that produce ocean renewable energy. Exempts ocean renewable energy facilities from regulation as hydroelectric projects

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under certain conditions. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Bentz)

SB 472 A-Eng. **HTED** **dp** **5/22/2015** **Huffman**
Increases, from 40,000 sets to 80,000 sets, the number of Pacific Wonderland vehicle registration plates that may be issued. Deletes provision requiring revenues from Pacific Wonderland plate surcharge allocation to Oregon State Capitol Foundation. Requires moneys to be used for establishing and maintaining an Oregon History Center at the State Capitol or the Oregon State Capitol Park. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Exc., 1 --Bentz)

SB 521 **HHC** **dp** **5/22/2015** **Keny-Guyer**
Permits coach to allow member of school athletic team or non-school athletic team to participate in athletic event or training after athletic trainer determines that member has not suffered concussion. Allows athletic trainer to consult with health care professional in making determination. Defines "health care professional." Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 672 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **5/22/2015** **Hayden**
Directs Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to appoint state dental director to oversee programs operated by OHA that increase access to oral health services. Requires dental director to study and make recommendations on improving oral health. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 714 A-Eng. **HTED** **dp** **5/22/2015** **Davis**
Prohibits motor vehicle manufacturers, distributors and importers from taking any adverse action against a motor vehicle dealer because the dealer sold a motor vehicle to a customer that subsequently exported the vehicle or resold it for export. Provides exceptions. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Exc., 1 --Bentz)

SB 790 A-Eng. **HED** **dp** **5/22/2015** **Piluso**
Requires Department of Justice (DOJ) to encourage and support services, programs and curricula to educate and inform students in grades seven to twelve about domestic violence, to provide assistance to victims of domestic violence, and to prevent and reduce incidence of

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domestic violence. Requires school district boards to adopt policies that incorporate age-appropriate education about domestic violence into training programs for students in grades seven to twelve and school employees. Authorizes Department of Human Services to make grants to and enter into contracts with nonprofit organizations or public agencies for programs and projects designed to prevent, identify, and treat domestic violence. Requires Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to adopt specified rules and provide school districts with posters in both English and Spanish providing toll-free hotline telephone number students may call for information and help. Requires school district boards to adopt policies requiring posting of signs in clearly visible locations on school campuses. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 263 B-Eng. **HEE** **dpa PE** **5/26/2015** **Reardon**

Makes changes to program elements that may be used by cities and counties to fulfill requirements to implement recycling programs. Authorizes local governments to assess fee on solid waste collection or disposal services to cover costs to local government for providing opportunity to recycle and implementing program requirements. Establishes requirements for education and promotion programs provided by city, county or metropolitan service district responsible for providing opportunity to recycle. Updates waste generation goals for calendar years 2025 and 2050 and subsequent years. Identifies specific voluntary recovery goals for certain counties. Allows Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) to revise goals under certain conditions. Directs EQC to develop and adopt alternative method for calculating recovery rates based on rate of energy savings achieved through recovery of materials. Authorizes EQC to adopt other alternative calculation methods under certain conditions. Reduces required frequency of statewide solid waste composition study to once every three biennia. Requires Department of Environmental Quality to conduct statewide survey of recovery rates for certain materials for calendar year 2020 and 2025 and report to Legislature if goals are not being met. **House Amendment Directs DEQ to include in 2019 report to Legislative Assembly an evaluation of costs of implementing multitenant recycling within urban growth boundary of cities with population of 4,000 or more that have not fully implemented multitenant recycling.**

Requires public employer of arresting officer to pay for qualified interpreter for person with disability upon arrest. Removes requirement that court make determination on means and ability of person with disability. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)
