Extends by four years period during which universities with institutional governing boards must participate in shared services relating to listed employee benefits and collective bargaining. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **Senate Amendment Specifies that during period public university is required to participate in shared services, university must provide same scope and overall value of certain employee benefits as required by specified statutes.**

Directs Department of Human Services (DHS) to permit and monitor savings accounts for children age 12 or older in DHS custody, via rulemaking. Entitles children in DHS custody for six months or more, to assistance establishing savings accounts. Prohibits DHS or other legal guardian from establishing accounts on behalf of child. Allows DHS to monitor use of child's money relating to state and federal benefits. **Senate Amendment Removes requirement that Department of Human Services (DHS) actively encourage use of savings accounts. Clarifies that assistance establishing accounts is to be provided by DHS. Adds provisions establishing child's capacity to contract, enabling financial institutions to permit youth to make deposits and withdrawals, and to rely on youth's signature. Removes references to child care agencies and foster parents.** (Senate Vote: Ayes, 28; excused, 2--Boquist, Olsen.)

Allows district school board to enter into transactions that are expected to reduce cost to district for school facilities. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **Senate Amendment Clarifies that district school board may enter into an agreement or take any other action that would allow the district to use state or federal funding "sources" rather than "services."** (Senate Vote: Ayes, 20; nays, 8--Baertschiger Jr, Boquist, Ferrioli, Girod, Hansell, Thatcher, Thomsen, Winters; excused, 2--Beyer, Olsen.)

SB 534 **HRCLUW** **dp** **5/28/2015** **Huffman, Gilliam**

Authorizes city and airport to enter into agreement pursuant to which the city provides sewer and water service to airport without requiring annexation, or consent to eventual annexation, to city of territory where airport is located. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Exc., 1 --Gomberg)

SB 36 A-Eng. **HREV** **dp** **6/2/2015** **Davis**

Makes technical changes to Oregon tax statutes. Modernizes language. Repeals outdated statutes including a pre-2004 limit on land that can be designated as tax exempt riparian land, and outdated references to the Multistate Tax Compact. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 298 A-Eng. **HHC** **dp** **6/2/2015** **Clem**

Adds bodywork to definition of massage. Modifies definition of massage to clarify that "Massage does not mean the practicing of any form of high velocity, short amplitude, manipulative thrusting procedures provided to the articulations of the spine or extremities." Excludes community colleges and accredited colleges and universities from definition of "massage facility." Modifies massage therapists certified class hours from 500 to 625. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Nay, 3 --Buehler, Hayden, Weidner)

SB 430 A-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **6/2/2015** **Kennemer**

Makes explicit State Board's authority to deny licensure due to conviction for sex crime. Applies to the Board of Psychologist Examiners, Licensed Social Workers and Licensed Professional Counselors. **House Amendment Authorizes the Board of Psychologist Examiners, Licensed Social Workers and Licensed Professional Counselors to deny, revoke or not renew license for individual convicted of a sex crime in Oregon or other state or jurisdiction.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 505 **HHC** **dp** **6/2/2015** **Greenlick**

Requires that, from October 1 through March 1, each hospital shall offer immunizations against influenza virus to patients 65 years and older. Specifies that the offers are based on availability of influenza vaccine and the recommendation of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Nay, 3 --Buehler, Hayden, Lively)

SB 574 A-Eng. **HBL** **dp** **6/2/2015** **Esquivel, Boone**

Requires person providing restoration work on residential or small commercial structure following disaster to have appropriate license endorsement issued by Construction Contractors Board.

Directs Board to adopt rules for issuing residential restoration contractor license endorsement in time to make endorsements available by January 1, 2017. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9; Nay, 2 -- Heard, Kennemer)

SB 705 B-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **6/2/2015** **Keny-Guyer**

Directs Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) to adopt rules requiring accredited inspector to perform asbestos survey for purpose of determining whether a residence or residential building is insulated with asbestos prior to demolition of the residence or residential building. Directs the EQC to include an exemption for residences constructed by a date specified by the commission. **House Amendment Deletes the requirement that a contractor survey the premises, and directs the EQC to adopt rules to have an accredited inspector conduct the survey. Directs the EQC to include an exemption for residences constructed by a date specified by the commission.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 713 B-Eng. **HBL** **dpa PE** **6/2/2015** **Fagan**

Prohibits a manufacturer from requiring motor vehicle dealer to promote, offer, or sell extended service contracts, extended maintenance plans or similar products, with exceptions. Provides for fair and reasonable compensation to the dealer when the manufacturer terminates, cancels or fails to renew a franchise or terminates a product line. Prohibits a manufacturer from imposing separate charges or surcharges to recover the cost of compensation to the dealer for warranty parts or

Requires Oregon Health Authority to disseminate information to health care professionals and public related to adrenal insufficiency. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 901 B-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **6/2/2015** **Lively**

Requires provider that bills insurer for covered medical, mental or substance use disorder health services to be reimbursed directly by insurer. Adds exemption for disability type of payor (AFLAC) (ORS 743.730). Applies to reimbursements on claims on or after January 1, 2017. **House Amendment Adds exemption for disability type of payor (AFLAC) (ORS 743.730) and substance use disorder and mental health services as covered services by insurers.**

SB 259 A-Eng. **HEE** **dp** **6/3/2015** **Reardon**

Requires Energy Facility Siting Council (EFSC) to evaluate notice of intent or request for expedited review of site certificate application. Authorizes EFSC to compensate state agency or local government incurring expenses directly related to evaluation activities for consultation initiated by applicant for notice of intent or request for expedited review prior to submittal of notice or request; limits such expenses to those established in estimate and agreed to by applicant and excludes legal expenses of agency or local government incurred as result of participation in contested case. Authorizes EFSC to compensate tribe identified by Commission on Indian Services for expenses directly related to certain evaluation activities related to site certificates. Requires person submitting notice of intent to file for site certificate, request for exemption, or request for expedited review, to pay fee in advance. Authorizes EFSC to periodically review documents, reports or other materials to ensure compliance with terms and conditions of site certificate, or request another agency or local government to do so and compensate them for same. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

Exempts carbon dioxide emissions from combustion or decomposition of biomass from regulation under certain air pollution laws unless necessary to implement federal Clean Air Act. Defines "biomass." Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Nay, 1 --Holvey)

SB 829 A-Eng. **HEE** **dp** **6/3/2015** **Bentz**

Directs Department of Environmental Quality to solicit independent scientific and technical input and provide adequate public notice, opportunity for public comment and informational overview before Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) on draft assessment methodologies when developing or selecting among methodologies to assess state waters under federal Water Pollution Control Act and prior to publishing draft water body assessments based on such methodologies. Requires EQC to provide public comment opportunity on draft assessment methodologies during EQC meeting at which informational overview takes place. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

Changes the requirement for operating a moped or motorcycle by allowing a person to stand or stand astride while operating the vehicle. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7)

SB 881 **HAGNR** **dp** **6/3/2015** **Witt**

Provides that Cannabis sativa seed not intended for planting but remaining capable of germination is agricultural hemp seed. Includes seed processed in manner or to extent rendering seed incapable of germination in definition of "industrial hemp." Provides that handling of seeds or seed products processed in manner or to extent of being incapable of germination does not require agricultural hemp seed production permit. Reduces term of industrial hemp licenses and agricultural hemp seed production permits from three years to one year. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Nay, 2 --Barreto, Whitsett; Exc., 1 --McKeown)

SB 137 A-Eng. HBL dp 6/5/2015 Holvey

Modifies definition of "public works" for the purpose of applying prevailing wage to include projects that use at least \$750,000 of public funds for construction, reconstruction, painting or major renovation on a publicly- or privately-owned road, highway, building, structure or improvement. Becomes operative on January 1, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 9; Nay, 2 --Barreto, Weidner)

SB 187 A-Eng. HED dp 6/5/2015 Doherty

Enacts Oregon Student Information Protection Act (OSIPA). Prohibits operator of website, service, or application designed for kindergarten through grade 12 educational purposes from engaging in targeted advertising, amassing student profiles, selling student information, or disclosing covered information. Allows limited disclosure of information made to further school purposes, to comply with legal and regulatory requirements, to participate in judicial proceedings, and to protect safety of user or integrity of application. Requires operator to implement and retain reasonable security procedures and practices, and to delete students' covered information within reasonable time of request to delete. Allows disclosure of covered student information if required by law, for legitimate research purposes, or if made to a state or local educational agency. Specifies circumstances for disclosure of information. Makes violation of Act unlawful business practice enforceable by Attorney General. Becomes effective July 1, 2016. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5; Nay, 4 --Barreto, Hack, Sprenger, Wilson)

SB 256 A-Eng. **JWM** **dp** **6/4/2015** **Rayfield**

Authorizes Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) to adopt certification standards for persons dealing in nursery stock. Requires ODA to consider certification standards adopted by federal government, another state or national association for nurseries when establishing certification standards. Authorizes ODA to establish expedited permitting process for people affected by wildflower and nursery stock statutes that participate and meet standards of ODA certification program. Increases maximum license fee for growers from \$20,000 to \$40,000 and maximum millage rate from no more than five to 10 mills. Authorizes ODA Director to suspend or revoke shipping permit issued if nursery has stock that does not meet interstate shipment cleanliness standards. Increases maximum amount of annual license fee for growers of Christmas trees from \$75 to \$110 for basic charge, from \$3 to \$4.50 per acre. Increases total license fee for growers of Christmas trees from \$5,000 to \$7,000. (Committee Vote: Aye, 19; Nay, 3 --McLane, Whitsett, Thomsen; Exc., 2 --Read, Hansell)

SB 462 A-Eng. **HBL** **dp** **6/5/2015** **Kenemer**

Changes provisions of the secured transactions section of the Uniform Commercial Code. Provides that a record is effective as financing statement if record satisfies requirement for financing statement and sufficiently provides name of debtor. Requires financing statement to show name of individual debtor as indicated on unexpired driver license or identification card for sufficiency of name on financing statement. Provides phase-in period for financing statements perfected under current law. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 11)

SB 523 B-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **6/4/2015** **Kenemer**

Requires insurer to notify provider that the enrollee is in a grace period when enrollee fails to pay premium for the qualified health plan, if the provider requests information regarding coverage, eligibility or benefits. Specifies conditions that requires insurer to reimburse provider for services performed during the grace period when coverage is terminated. Specifies requirements may not be waived by agreement or contract. Directs insurer, upon inquiries from provider, to respond that coverage is provided. Requires that a provider request the information from the insurer not more than seven (7) business days before providing the service and that the insurer provides the information to the provider no later than two (2) business days after the request is made. Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to produce written materials for consumers about paying premiums and distribute to providers upon request. **House Amendment Adds the requirement that a provider request the information from the insurer not more than 7 business days before providing the service and that the insurer provides the information to the provider no later than 2 business days after the request is made.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

SB 578 A-Eng. **HBL** **dpa PE** **6/5/2015** **Barreto**
 Permits insurer, under certain conditions, to post insurance policy and endorsements on insurer's website in lieu of mailing or delivering insurance policy and endorsements to insured. **House Amendment Provides exemption from the consent and notice requirements of the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 11)

SB 684 A-Eng. **HHC** **dpa PE** **6/4/2015** **Buehler**
 Permits the Oregon Medical Board (OMB) to issue a limited license to practice medicine to physicians who are licensed in another state or country and who hold a full-time professor appointment at a school of medicine in Oregon. Specifies that OMB can only issue eight licenses in a four-year period. Operative date is January 1, 2016. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Specifies additional criteria to be used by OMB in issuing a limited license. Specifies that OMB can only issue eight licenses in a four-year period.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 9)

 Permits licensed insurance producers to be the licensees for products distributed through non-licensed travel retailers if specific conditions protecting consumers are met, including registration of the agents, training, and consumer disclosures. Becomes operative July 1, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Changes operative date to July 1, 2016.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 11)

 Makes pre-disaster measures taken to improve resilience inadmissible as evidence of negligence. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 7)

SB 820 B-Eng. **HED** **dpa PE** **6/5/2015** **Huffman**
 Allows public charter school to implement weighted lottery for historically underserved students. Defines "historically underserved students." Sunsets authorization for weighted lotteries in 2020-21 school year. Mandates review of and report on the implementation of weighted lotteries prior to sunset. Requires consideration of combination of "two or more" factors in determination of traditionally underserved status.
