<u>HB 2547 B-Eng.</u>	<u>JWM</u>	dpa PE	6/26/2015	Hoyle
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Directs Department of Human Services to convene and staff The Task Force on Housing with Services to define housing with services; define consumer rights; set standards for licensure and registration; and define safety standards. Specifies task force membership. Directs DHS to enact six month moratorium on new housing with services facilities. Sunsets task force on December 31, 2015. Requires report to legislature on or before December 31, 2015. (Committee Vote: Aye, 22; Nay, 2 --Whitsett, Whitsett)

<u>HB 2955 A-Eng.</u>	<u>JWM</u>	dpa PE	6/26/2015	Whisnant
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Directs Department of Education to administer process for providing funding for activities related to annual conference dedicated to Oregon civics and held on Oregon Civics Day for Teachers. Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for purpose of conference. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. **House Amendment Strikes the appropriation clause from the bill.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 21; Nay, 3 --Smith, Girod, Thomsen)

<u>HB 3333</u>	<u>JWM</u>	dp	6/26/2015	Gomberg
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Requires that portion of surcharge moneys from salmon registration plate program transferred to the Watershed Conservation Grant Fund, administered by the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, be used solely for funding projects to protect or restore native salmon habitat or restore natural watershed or ecosystem functions by removing artificial obstructions to native salmon migration. (Committee Vote: Aye, 24)

Third Reading Of Senate Bills:
(Requires Rule Suspension)

SB 32 A-Eng. **JWM** **dp** **6/26/2015** **Nearman**

Directs Public Utility Commission (PUC) to form work group to study methods by which natural gas public utility may expand service to areas that do not currently have access to natural gas. Directs PUC to include in work group representatives of public utilities that furnish natural gas, other energy suppliers, local governments, and elected officials; stakeholders who have interest in study outcome; and individuals with subject matter knowledge. Requires PUC to report study results to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to energy by September 15, 2016. Sunsets on January 2, 2017. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 22; Nay, 1 -- Thomsen; Exc., 1 --Rayfield)

SB 832 C-Eng. **HRULES** **dpa PE** **6/26/2015** **Kennemer**

Establishes behavioral health homes to be used by coordinated care organizations (CCOs). Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) set standards for achieving integration of behavioral and physical health services in patient-centered primary care homes and behavioral health homes via rulemaking. Permits use of applicable billing codes by providers in patient-centered primary care homes and behavioral health homes. Creates necessary definitions, including "integrated behavioral health care" and "behavioral health home." Declares emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Resolves conflict with House Bill 2419 (2015).** (Committee Vote: Aye, 8; Exc., 1 --Kennemer)
