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Third Reading Of Senate Measures:

<u>SB 964 A-Eng.</u>	<u>SIM91</u>	dpa PE	5/22/2015	Burdick, Kruse
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Requires medical marijuana registry identification cardholders (cardholders), medical marijuana growers (growers), medical marijuana processors (processors) and medical marijuana dispensaries (dispensaries) be registered with Oregon Health Authority (OHA). Provides exemptions for licensing. Describes OHA licensing process for cardholders, growers, processors and dispensaries. Requires Oregon residency to receive registry identification card. Requires at least two years of Oregon residency for growers, processors and those persons responsible for dispensaries. Requires processors and dispensary owners be at least 21 years of age. Limits grower to 24 mature plants if grow site is within city limits and in location zoned for residential use or 96 mature plants if grow site is not in previously described area, so long as grow site was registered with OHA prior to January 1, 2015. Limits grower to 12 mature plants if grow site is within city limits and in location zoned for residential use or 48 mature plants if grow site is not in previously described area if grower registers grow site after December 31, 2014. Limits amount of usable marijuana grower may possess to 12 pounds per outdoor plant or 6 pounds per indoor plant. Requires grower to reduce plant count if specific events occur. Establishes tracking system for growers, processors and dispensaries. Allows OHA to inspect only marijuana grow sites of persons designated to produce marijuana for other cardholders. Allows cardholder to reimburse person responsible for grow site for all costs associated with production of marijuana. Requires OHA to establish by rule public health and safety standards for processor of cannabinoid edibles, concentrates and extracts. Allows OHA to provide information regarding grow site, processing site or dispensary to law enforcement or regulatory agency of city or county. Prohibits OHA from providing specified information. Requires OHA to provide information to law enforcement agencies if OHA suspends license, revokes license or takes disciplinary action against grower, processor or dispensary. Defines terms. **Senate Amendment Prohibits local governments from regulating delivery of medical marijuana except as expressly authorized by statutory laws of Oregon. Clarifies definition of "reasonable regulations." Changes operative date for section dealing with dispensary re-registration if public or private school opens within 1,000 feet after the dispensary has been established.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

Authorizes city to adopt, and Director of Department of Land Conservation and Development to approve, work program that includes only changes required on remand if periodic review is initiated. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 1 -Thomsen)

HB 3329 **SENR** **dp** **5/22/2015** **Whitsett**

Modifies standard by which geothermal energy qualifies as type of green energy technology for which at least 1.5 percent of total contract price of certain public improvement contract for construction, reconstruction or major renovation of public school building must be spent. Applies to contracts first advertised, or if not advertised, first entered into, on or after effective date of Act. Act takes effect on 91st day after date on which regular session of Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 1 --Thomsen)

HB 3378 A-Eng. **SHC** **dp** **5/22/2015** **Knopp**

Requires hospitals to adopt written discharge policies. Modifies definition of lay caregiver. Specifies topics to be included in the discharge policy, that patient and lay caregiver are provided instruction or training prior to discharge, and that the hospital notify the lay caregiver of the patient's discharge. Specifies policy requirements. (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 1 --Knopp)

HB 2394 A-Eng. **SHSEC** **dp** **5/26/2015** **Olsen**
 Requires State Lottery to inform Department of Human Services within seven days of paying lottery prize of \$1,250 or more. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 1 --Dembrow)

HB 2419 B-Eng. **SHC** **dpa PE** **5/22/2015** **Monnes Anderson**
 Modifies the definition of "health care interpreter" to include sign language interpreters. Revises the membership of the Oregon Council on Health Care Interpreters to include a health care interpreter. Prohibits the use of the title "Oregon certified health care interpreter" without specific requirements. Clarifies qualifications and certification requirements. Modifies health care data reporting requirements. Changes references to Oregon Health Policy and Research to Oregon Health Authority. Modifies qualifications for Public Health Officer. Removes references to Blue Mountain Recovery Center. Aligns references relating to screening interviews and treatment programs for alcohol and drug diversion programs. **Senate Amendment Resolves statutory conflict. Repeals section regarding health care workforce database with information to be collected from professional licensing boards.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 3; Exc., 2 --Knopp, Kruse)

HB 3464 B-Eng. **SHC** **dpa PE** **5/22/2015** **Shields**
 Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to adopt rules regarding time frames within which a pregnant medical assistance recipient, reimbursed under fee-for-service, needs general or

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specialty dental care. Specifies services to be covered and that the fee-for-service time frames are to be the same as pregnant recipients in coordinated care organizations and dental care organizations. Directs OHA to report to the Legislative Assembly no later than December 1, 2016. Establishes January 1, 2016 as the operative date. **Senate Amendment Clarifies time frame to be prescribed for recipients reimbursed under fee-for-service. Clarifies time frames must be consistent with pregnant population enrolled in coordinated care organizations and dental care organizations. Removes the requirement that a recipient receive dental screening within 30 days.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 1 --Knopp)

Provides for employer and employee contributions to pension program and individual account program (IAP) of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan to first be made for new members for wages attributed to services performed for the first full pay period following the six-month probationary period, without regard to when wages are considered earned for other purposes.
