<u>SB 377 B-Eng.</u>	<u>SJUD</u>	Concur	5/27/2015	Prozanski
<p>Modifies "Computer Crime" statute to specifically include "theft of an intimate image" as prohibited conduct. Amends ORS 137.540 by re-ordering the general conditions of probation. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. House Amendment Adds technical re-ordering of the general conditions of probation so that the chronological order is symmetrical with the general conditions of post-prison supervision as it was prior to HB 3194 from the 2013 legislative session. HB 2038 A-Eng. **SJUD** **dp** **5/28/2015** **Johnson**
 Limits liability of land owners for damages resulting from use of land for aviation activities. Provides exceptions. Defines relevant terms. Applies to personal injuries, death and property damage occurring on or after the effective date. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

HB 2597 A-Eng. **SED** **dp** **5/28/2015** **Gelser**
 Requires truancy notice to parent or person in parental relation of right to request evaluation for Individualized Education Program (IEP) or review of existing IEP. Prohibits scheduling of attendance conference between parent or guardian of student, student, and designated official until evaluation or review has been completed. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Exc., 1 --Gelser)

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HB 2693 **SJUD** **dp** **5/28/2015** **Prozanski**
 Creates crime of encouraging sexual assault of an animal carrying maximum penalty of one year imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both. Raises classification of crime of sexual assault of an animal from Class A misdemeanor to Class C felony and punishes by maximum of five years imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both. Increases length of time person convicted of sexual assault of an animal is prohibited from possessing certain animals from five to fifteen years. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

HB 3069 B-Eng. **SED** **dpa** **5/27/2015** **Gelser**
 Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC) to adopt rules to require students in education programs to be able to instruct pupils to meet or exceed third-grade reading standards by end of third grade. Mandates that any education program unable to plan to meet requirements under rule within one year report to TSPC. **Senate Amendment Resolves conflicts with HB 2412 (2015).** (Committee Vote: Aye, 6; Exc., 1 --Baertschiger Jr)

HB 3523 A-Eng. **JWM** **dp** **5/28/2015** **Devlin**
 Reorganizes mission and governance of State Library. Changes name of Trustees of State Library to State Library Board, changes composition and number of board members, and provides for Governor rather than Trustees of State Library to appoint State Librarian. Establishes State Reference Coordinating Council consisting of State Librarian, State Archivist and State of Oregon Law Librarian to coordinate interagency delivery of services between state agencies and ensure collaboration. Provides for State Library to approve selection, purchase and maintenance of reference databases and subscriptions for state agencies other than databases, services and resources provided by State Archives and State of Oregon Law Library. Directs State Library to biennially certify any state agency library maintained separate from State Library. (Committee Vote: Aye, 18; Nay, 3 --Whitsett, Hansell, Whitsett; Exc., 3 --McLane, Whisnant, Thomsen)
