<u>SB 153 A-Eng.</u>	<u>SHC</u>	Concur	5/28/2015	Monnes Anderson
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Clarifies insurance reimbursement of primary care or mental health services by physician assistants and certified nurse practitioners in independent practice. Requires use of national provider identifier of the physician assistant, nurse practitioner or facility in which physician assistant or nurse practitioner provides services. **House Amendment Provides additional reimbursement criteria for nurse practitioners and physician assistants.** (House Vote: Ayes, 52; Nays, 1--Post; Absent, 1--Keny-Guyer; Excused, 1--McKeown; Excused for Business of the House, 5--Bentz, Buckley, Davis, Vega Pederson, Speaker Kotek.)

<u>SB 188 B-Eng.</u>	<u>SJUD</u>	Concur	5/28/2015	Prozanski
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Creates crime of unlawful dissemination of an intimate image. Prohibits the nonconsensual disclosure of an intimate picture to a website with a specific intent to harass, humiliate, or injure another person. Establishes that the first violation is a Class A misdemeanor, with each subsequent violation being a Class C felony. Defines terms. Defines exceptions, including immunity for interactive computer services as they are defined by the Federal Communication Decency Act. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. **House Amendment Adds an emergency clause. Defines immunity given to interactive computer services so that it mirrors the immunity given by the Federal Communications Decency Act.** (House Vote: Ayes, 58; Excused, 1--Hayden; Excused for Business of the House, 1--Speaker Kotek.)

<u>SB 230 B-Eng.</u>	<u>SHC</u>	Concur	5/28/2015	Monnes Anderson
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Specifies and requires healthcare workers to submit demographic, education and other information to the healthcare workforce regulatory boards. Specifies that an individual submit the information when renewing a license with the board. Transfers the maintaining of the information from the Oregon Office for Health Policy and Research to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA). Directs OHA to collaborate with each board to adopt rules on demographics and other information. Clarifies when board may release personally identifiable information to OHA. Requires OHA to use collected information from the healthcare workforce database. Establishes that database includes data on state healthcare workforce diversity, and that OHA can contract with private entity to maintain and analyze data. Adds training to the list of information to be submitted. Removes the

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agency's exemption status from public contracting code. Sets January 1, 2016 as operative date. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Removes the agency's exemption status from public contracting code.** (House Vote: Ayes, 40; Nays, 12--Buehler, Hack, Heard, Johnson, McLane, Nearman, Post, Sprenger, Stark, Whisnant, Whitsett, Wilson; Absent, 1--Keny-Guyer; Excused, 2--Gorsek, McKeown; Excused for Business of the House, 5--Bentz, Buckley, Davis, Vega Pederson, Speaker Kotek.)

SB 280 B-Eng. **SHC** **Concur** **5/28/2015** **Monnes Anderson**

Changes Board of Medical Imaging (Board) twelve-member composition. Specifies one must be licensed physician who is radiologist and in "good standing." Specifies three must be licensed physicians in "good standing" and five must be "actively engaged" medical imaging licensees. Requires that if the Board cannot fill physician spots, the Governor may appoint any combination of the following: a chiropractic physician certified by the American Chiropractic Board of Radiology; an actively engaged medical imaging licensee; a limited X-ray machine operator and a member of the public. Allows Governor to appoint retired physician to the Board if he/she has not been retired for more than six years; they are registered with the Oregon Medical Board (OMB) as retired emeritus physician; or who has notified the OMB of retirement and is in good standing. Defines "actively engaged." Declares emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Allows Governor to appoint retired physician to the Board if he/she has not been retired for more than six years; who is registered with the Oregon Medical Board (OMB) as retired emeritus physician; or who has notified the OMB of retirement and is in good standing.** (House Vote: Ayes, 50; Absent, 1--Gallegos; Excused, 2--Gorsek, McKeown; Excused for Business of the House, 7--Bentz, Buckley, Davis, Komp, Liningner, Vega Pederson, Speaker Kotek.)

SB 474 A-Eng. **SHSEC** **Concur** **5/28/2015** **Gelser**

Permits existing dental clinics for special needs children to be operated by charitable corporations, as specified. Clarifies that clinic/program has to be at an existing, single fixed location or one or more mobile locations. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Clarifies that clinic/program has to be at an existing, single fixed location or one or more mobile locations.** (House Vote: Ayes, 50; Absent, 1--Gallegos; Excused, 2--Gorsek, McKeown; Excused for Business of the House, 7--Bentz, Buckley, Davis, Komp, Liningner, Vega Pederson, Speaker Kotek.)

SB 662 A-Eng. **SHC** **Concur** **5/28/2015** **Monnes Anderson**

Requires that a dental instructor's license issued to a specialist be restricted to the specialty for which the applicant completed their advanced dental education program. Clarifies that a dental instructor either be a graduate of an accredited dental school or has a certificate or degree showing successful completion of an advanced dental education program from an accredited dental school. **House Amendment Clarifies that a dental instructor either be a graduate of an accredited dental school or has a certificate or degree showing successful completion of an advanced dental education program from an accredited dental school.** (House Vote:

SB 759 B-Eng. **SED** **Concur** **5/28/2015** **Roblan**

Requires public universities, community colleges and Oregon-based private universities and colleges to adopt written protocols for responding to sexual assault involving student, faculty or staff. Protocols are to be posted on institutional website and distributed to students at orientation. Requires protocols ensure that victims who report sexual assault are provided with written notification containing information on their rights, legal options, campus-based services and state- and community-based resources. **House Amendment Expands applicability beyond university facilities to apply in all cases involving students, faculty and staff of the institution regardless of location of the assault. Adds requirement that written protocol be made available to students during orientation and on university website.** (House Vote: Ayes, 54; Absent, 1--Keny-Guyer; Excused, 1--McKeown; Excused for Business of the House, 4--Bentz, Buckley, Davis, Vega Pederson.)

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SB 255 **JWM** **do pass** **6/1/2015** **Dembrow**
 Raises limit on fees for annual registration of animal remedy, veterinary biologic or pharmaceutical from \$75 to \$150. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. (Committee Vote: Aye, 21; Nay, 1 -Thomsen; Exc., 2 --Read, Hansell)

SB 256 A-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/1/2015** **Hansell**
 Authorizes Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) to adopt certification standards for persons dealing in nursery stock. Requires ODA to consider certification standards adopted by federal government, another state or national association for nurseries when establishing certification standards. Authorizes ODA to establish expedited permitting process for people affected by wildflower and nursery stock statutes that participate and meet standards of ODA certification program. Increases maximum license fee for growers from \$20,000 to \$40,000 and maximum millage rate from no more than five to 10 mills. Authorizes ODA Director to suspend or revoke shipping permit issued if nursery has stock that does not meet interstate shipment cleanliness standards. Increases maximum amount of annual license fee for growers of Christmas trees from \$75 to \$110 for basic charge, from \$3 to \$4.50 per acre. Increases total license fee for growers of Christmas trees from \$5,000 to \$7,000. (Committee Vote: Aye, 19; Nay, 3 --McLane, Whitsett, Thomsen; Exc., 2 --Read, Hansell)

SB 886 A-Eng. **SRULES** **do pass as amended, print engrossed** **5/29/2015** **Beyer**
 Requires State Fire Marshal, deputy or assistant of State Fire Marshal, or person acting for governmental subdivision who inspects structure and issues citation or order for nonconformity with federal, state or local fire safety standard, to include on citation or order: exact reference to law, regulation, rule or other source of authority that establishes the fire safety standard and plain statement of facts upon which citation or order is based. **Senate Amendment Replaces original measure.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 3; Exc., 2 --Burdick, Ferrioli)

HB 5004 A-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **5/28/2015** **Johnson**
 Agency: Department of Aviation (Committee Vote: Aye, 21; Exc., 3 --McLane, Whisnant, Thomsen)

HB 2023 B-Eng. **SHC** **do pass as amended, print engrossed** **5/29/2015** **Monnes Anderson**
 Directs hospitals to adopt and enforce discharge policies for individuals that have been treated for behavioral health crisis. Specifies criteria to be included in the policy. Sets July 1, 2016 as

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operative date. **Senate Amendment Modifies the definition of lay caregiver. Makes clarifications relating to coordinating care and transitioning patients. Requires documenting when scheduling follow-up appointments within 7-days of discharge cannot be met.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

HB 2028 A-Eng. **SHC** **do pass** **6/1/2015** **Kruse**

Directs the State Board of Pharmacy to adopt rules that permit pharmacists to engage in the practice of clinical pharmacy. Defines "clinical pharmacy agreement" and "practice of clinical pharmacy." Permits health insurers to provide payment or reimbursement for services provided by the pharmacist through the practice of clinical pharmacy or pursuant to the statewide drug therapy management protocol. Limits participation from "practitioner" to physician. Adds Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations to reimburse pharmacist or pharmacy under specified situations. States that for this statute, a pharmacist is classified as a primary care provider. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

HB 2130 A-Eng. **SFR** **do pass** **6/1/2015** **Hass**

Allows governing bodies to establish reasonable maximum holding times for land designated for low-income housing development and allows governing bodies to elect additional qualifying criteria. Requires additional criteria to not conflict with existing law criteria. Changes apply only to applications for exemption received on or after the effective date of measure and date on which the governing body adopts the reasonable maximum holding times and/or additional criteria. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

HB 2182 **SENR** **do pass** **6/1/2015** **Olsen**

Requires Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) to study developing statewide predator management plan. Requires ODFW to present report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources on or before September 15, 2016. Sunsets January 2, 2017. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

HB 2349 A-Eng. **SJUD** **do pass** **6/1/2015** **Burdick**

Modifies information required in petition for appointment of professional fiduciary. Requires inclusion of investment credentials and securities licensing information for individual responsible as, or acting on behalf of, professional fiduciary. Requires disclosure of revenue sharing and method of fee determination. Requires annual accounting to court to include total compensation that investment advisers or brokers, other than professional fiduciary, charged or received for investment management. Includes acknowledgment that professional fiduciary will make all investments in accordance with the Uniform Prudent Investor Act. (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 1 --Thatcher)

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
