SB 963 **SRULES** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Johnson**

Prohibits contractor or subcontractor, or contractor's or subcontractor's agent, from intentionally failing to pay prevailing rate of wage, reducing rate of wage for work that is not subject to prevailing wage in order to recoup prevailing wages that contractor, subcontractor or agent paid, withholding, deducting or diverting employee's wages other than as provided by law, entering into agreement under terms of which employee receives less than prevailing rate of wage for work that is subject to prevailing rate of wage, or otherwise permanently or indefinitely depriving employee of 25 percent or more of prevailing wages employee is due. Punishes violation by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both. Becomes operative January 1, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

HB 5046 A-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Steiner Hayward**

Provides continuing expenditure authority so that state agencies without adopted budgets for the 2015-17 biennium by July 1, 2015 can continue operations at the same level as the last quarter of the 2013-15 biennium. Provides exceptions for the Oregon Health Authority and the Department of Human Services. The continuing resolution also applies to any state agency budget that may be vetoed by the Governor. The continuing resolution expenditure authority is authorized through August 15, 2015. (Committee Vote: Aye, 21; Nay, 3 --Whitsett, Thomsen, Whitsett)

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HB 2016 B-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Monroe**

Requires Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to develop and implement statewide education plan for students enrolled in early childhood through post-secondary education who are black or African-American or students not covered under existing culturally specific statewide education plan, who have experienced disproportionate results in education due to historical practices, as identified in rule by State Board of Education (SBE). ODE will form advisory group including representatives from community, education stakeholders, Early Learning Division, Youth Development Division and Higher Education Coordinating Commission to advise ODE on development, implementation and grant eligibility criteria. SBE will adopt rules for implementation of plan. Specifies issues and strategies that plan must contain to address disparities amongst identified students. Requires ODE to submit biennial report to legislature. Directs ODE to award grants to early learning hubs, providers of early learning services, school districts, post-secondary institutions of education and community-based organizations to implement plan. Requires ODE to submit progress report to interim committee of legislature no later than January 1, 2016.

Appropriates money from General Fund to ODE to implement plan. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 21; Exc., 3 --McLane, Read, Girod)

HB 2230 **JWM** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Boquist**

Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to notify Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) of agreeable veterans' name and address. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015. Becomes operative January 1, 2016. (Committee Vote: Aye, 23; Exc., 1 --Winters)

HB 2255 A-Eng. **SRULES** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Dembrow**

Delays implementation of 11 to 1 ratio of nonsupervisory employees to supervisory employees until June 30, 2017. Establishes baseline ratio of nonsupervisory employees to supervisory employees during two-year delay. Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) report quarterly on agency ratios. Specifies content of report. Requires DAS notify labor organizations when reports are available. Provides that if agency increases its ratio of nonsupervisory employees to supervisory employees during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, increase can be credited to years after delay ends; provisions sunset June 30, 2019. Requires DAS to convene work group to study and report on appropriate ratios of nonsupervisory employees to supervisory employees. Work group is required to report on, or before, start of 2017 legislative session. Declares emergency, effective upon passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Nay, 1 --Boquist)

HB 2356 B-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Winters**

Modifies Invasion of Privacy statute to include two degrees of offenses. Increases penalties for recidivists and those who make recordings of others to a Class C felony. Adds ORS 163.700 to the criminal code. (Committee Vote: Aye, 23; Exc., 1 --Winters)

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HB 2474 A-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Whitsett**

Prohibits veterinary facilities from offering services related to veterinary medicine, surgery or dentistry unless facility registers with Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board (Board) and designates licensed veterinarian to ensure facility is in compliance with rules adopted by Board. Requires Board to adopt rules and specify fees for registering and renewing veterinary facility licenses and establish health and safety standards for veterinary facilities. Creates rules advisory committee and details committee membership. Authorizes Board to inspect facilities to ensure compliance with rules and suspend or revoke registration for failure to comply. (Committee Vote: Aye, 23; Exc., 1 --Winters)

HB 2734 C-Eng. **SFR** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Roblan**

Authorizes local governments to create land bank authority. Provides land bank authority powers and responsibilities. Details authority and duties of land bank authority and composition of land bank authority board. Clarifies that the authority is to exist as a legal entity separate from the local government that created it. Adds purpose of authority and language related to board of directors. Clarifies that a local government may incur debt, including issuance of bonds, on behalf of an authority it creates and clarifies that all assets owned by the authority, income earned by assets, and bonds issued by the authority and their income are exempt from taxation by State of Oregon. Provides method for dissolution of authority. Requires member of land bank authority board to file statement of economic interest with Oregon Government Ethics Commission. Exempts land bank authority from liability of remedial action costs or for damages of any spill or release of oil or hazardous material at facility acquired by authority under certain conditions. (Committee Vote: Aye, 5)

HB 2796 A-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/22/2015** **Steiner Hayward**

Authorizes the Health Licensing Office (HLO) to issue licenses to practice music therapy. Specifies licensing criteria for applicants. Authorizes HLO to adopt rules for licensing, qualifications and to establish standards. Prohibits persons from practicing music therapy or using the title of music therapist without a license. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 21; Exc., 3 --McLane, Read, Girod)
