<u>SB 833 B-Eng.</u>	<u>SHC</u>	Concur	6/25/2015	Monnes Anderson
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Requires Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to give coordinated care organizations (CCOs) at least 60 days' advance notice of any amendments proposed to existing contracts, or to contracts to be renewed, between OHA and coordinated care organizations. **House Amendment Removes requirement directing OHA to submit proposed terms or proposed amendments to CCO contract to appropriate federal agency for review and approval no less than 135 days prior to contract expiration.** (House Vote: Ayes, 54; Excused, 2--Bentz, Weidner; Excused for Business of the House, 4--Barnhart, McKeown, Sprenger, Speaker Kotek.)

<u>SB 875 B-Eng.</u>	<u>SED</u>	Concur	6/25/2015	Roblan
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Requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules regarding which school personnel may administer medications that treat adrenal insufficiency to students experiencing adrenal crisis. Requires training of school personnel to be conducted by the Oregon Health Authority under the supervision of a physician or nurse practitioner. Permits trained individuals, who receive medication from the parent or guardian of a student with adrenal insufficiency, to administer such medications if the student is suffering an adrenal crisis in an emergency situation when a licensed health care professional is not immediately available. Specifies that school districts are only required to have school personnel trained when a parent or guardian notifies the district that a student has been diagnosed with adrenal insufficiency. Operative January 1, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **House Amendment Resolves conflicts.** (House Vote: Ayes, 54; Excused, 2--Bentz, Weidner; Excused for Business of the House, 4--Barnhart, McKeown, Sprenger, Speaker Kotek.)

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Establishes limitations and deadlines for legislative measures for 2016 session of Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly. Limits Senate and House members to no more than two measure drafts. Limits Senate and House committees to no more than three drafts. Limits Governor and Chief Justice to no more than five measure drafts. Exempts Joint Committee on Ways and Means, Senate President, and House Committee on Rules from limitations. Requires all draft requests be submitted to Legislative Counsel on or before November 24, 2015 and all drafts to be filed at

Establishes an Outdoor Education Account in the State Treasury for the purpose of funding a six-day, residential, hands-on outdoor school program or equivalent for fifth and sixth grade students across the state. **Senate Amendment Removes the appropriation clause and relieves Oregon State University Extension Service from any duties or obligations unless funding is provided for expenses incurred.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 23; Exc., 1 --Rayfield)

Repeals sunset on authority of Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to contract with prepaid managed care health services organizations to provide care to medical assistance recipients. Defines prepaid managed care health services organization as managed dental care, mental health or chemical dependency organization that contracts with OHA or coordinated care organization on prepaid, capitated basis. Directs OHA to study effectiveness of dental care organizations in providing dental care and integration of dental care organizations into coordinated care organizations. Allows contract with private entity to conduct study. Requires OHA to report effects to interim committee of Legislative Assembly and appropriates \$150,000 for biennium. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **Senate Amendment Removes the requirement for a study, and removes the \$150,000 General Fund appropriation.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 24)

Codifies Early Learning Council's responsibility to develop funding for Early Learning Hubs as specified. Requires the Early Learning Council to develop metrics for the Hubs. Provides the Council authority to provide similar services and responsibilities as a Hub if there is no locally developed Hub. Requires annual reports by September 15th. Requires specified evaluation and report with recommendations to Legislature by February 1, 2019. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 17; Nay, 6 --McLane, Whisnant, Whitsett, Girod, Johnson, Whitsett; Exc., 1 --Rayfield)

SB 247 A-Eng. **JWM** **do pass as amended, print engrossed** **6/25/2015** **Dembrow**

Incrementally increases or establishes certain fees related to hunting, angling and commercial fishing over six-year period, applicable January 1, 2016, January 1, 2018, and January 1, 2020.

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Consolidates fee provisions for certain hunting and angling fees into statutory fee schedule. Modifies existing surcharges. Extends landowner preference program. Authorizes State Fish and Wildlife Commission to issue youth license to resident and nonresident persons 12 through 17 years of age. Declares emergency, effective on passage. **Senate Amendment Replaces the fee schedule in the original bill and includes intent to repeal January 1, 2020 incremental increase if the Legislatively Assembly enacts alternative revenue sources equal or greater to the anticipated revenue from the third incremental increases of tags and fees in 2020.**

SB 416 **JWM** **do pass** **6/26/2015** **Steiner Hayward**

Requires smoke shops to pay fee adopted by Oregon Health Authority (OHA) by rule. Requires fees for application for certification, renewal every five years, transfer of certification or application for relocation. Specifies fees must be reasonably calculated. Creates effective date of January 1, 2016. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 14; Nay, 9 --McLane, Huffman, Whisnant, Whitsett, Girod, Hansell, Thomsen, Whitsett, Winters; Exc., 2 --Rayfield, Johnson)

Requires all community college districts use same system for reporting finances. Requires Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development to select system, which may be existing system, and provide guidelines for implementation. Specifies what system shall include. Requires department to place data from system on website and ensure timely public access. Takes effect July 1, 2016. (Committee Vote: Aye, 22; Nay, 1 --Thomsen; Exc., 2 --McLane, Johnson)

Specifies task force membership, consisting exclusively of legislators. Directs Legislative Fiscal Officer and Legislative Revenue Officer to provide support for the task force. Directs task force to issue report to the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2016. (Committee Vote: Aye, 24)

HB 3335 A-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/26/2015** **Roblan**

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to work with public universities to address problem of students who successfully complete two or more years of coursework and leave with no official recognition of academic accomplishments. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 24)

HB 3414 B-Eng. **SRULES** **do pass as amended, print engrossed** **6/25/2015** **Burdick**

Creates offense of failure to keep vehicle in right lane on roads with posted speed greater than 55 miles per hour. Specifies offense does not occur when traffic is moving slower than normal flow of traffic. Designates offense as Class D traffic violation punishable by maximum fine of \$1,000. Exempts drivers of vehicles governed by ORS 811.325. Outlines conditions under which driving in the far left lane is allowable. **Senate Amendment Creates offense of failure to keep vehicle in right lane on roads with posted speed greater than 55 miles per hour. Changes penalty for failing to yield left lane from Class B to Class D traffic violation.** (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 1 --Beyer)

HB 3468 A-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/26/2015** **Shields**

Adds threatening to cause physical injury to animal to induce other person to engage in certain conduct as conduct constituting crime of coercion. Requires courts to impose minimum term of incarceration for initiating false report under certain circumstances. (Committee Vote: Aye, 24)

HB 3557 A-Eng. **SRULES** **do pass** **6/26/2015** **Burdick**

Restores clear and convincing public interest standard for release of public employees', volunteers' and others' personal information pursuant to public records request. Requires public bodies to delay response and forward such requests to affected persons or their representatives. Permits public body to recover costs associated with notifying individuals whose personal information is sought and for making determinations whether clear and convincing public interest standard has been met, regardless of whether information is disclosed. Provides civil and criminal

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immunity to public body or official of public body for harm caused by release of information based on its determination that clear and convincing evidence of public interest required disclosure.

Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 4; Exc., 1 --Beyer)

 Authorizes the Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule, standards and procedures for implementing alternative ballast water management strategies for vessels with empty ballast tanks that enter waters of state. (Committee Vote: Aye, 23; Exc., 1 --Girod)

HB 2936 C-Eng. **JWM** **do pass** **6/29/2015** **Steiner Hayward**
 Extends criminal and civil immunity to sobering facility and staff, registered with Oregon Health Authority (OHA) before January 1, 2016 for acting on probable cause in good faith without malice. Extends criminal and civil immunity to sobering facility and staff registered with OHA on or after January 1, 2016 for acting on probable cause in good faith without gross negligence. Defines sobering facility as one that: provides acutely intoxicated persons with safe, clean, supervised environment until sobriety improves; affiliates with OHA-approved addictions treatment program or provider; adopts comprehensive written policies and procedures incorporating best practices for safety of intoxicated persons, employees and volunteers; and is registered with OHA. Requires OHA to establish registry of sobering facilities. Permits OHA to register only facilities in operation when Act becomes effective and has submitted written request to OHA by December 31, 2015. Permits OHA to accept written requests from new sobering facilities after January 1, 2016, but prohibits registering more than three. Requires OHA to report on sobering facilities each regular legislative session beginning with 2017. Requires affiliated providers to enter into written agreement to consult, train, advise and make referrals. Allows for discharge of person who is danger to self or others within first 24 hours of admission. Prohibits disclosure of records without consent. Allows law enforcement to transport intoxicated person to sobering facility. Declares emergency, effective on passage. (Committee Vote: Aye, 23; Exc., 1 --Winters)
