<a href="#"><u>SB 1511</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means</b> Prohibits engaging in business of radon level testing or radon mitigation work without Department of Consumer and Business Services certification.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1512</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Makes Klamath Basin water right determined and established in order of determination existing water right for purposes of statute governing leasing of existing water rights for in-stream use.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1513</u></a>	<b>Rural Communities and Economic Development;Ways and Means</b> Establishes cost assistance program for reforestation of small woodlands following loss from catastrophic fire event.

<a href="#"><u>SB 1519</u></a>	<b>Health Care and Human Services</b> Requires dentist to test, at least once per week, autoclave or other heat sterilization device.

<a href="#"><u>SB 1541</u></a>	<b>Finance and Revenue</b> Extends sunset for tax credit for crop donation.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1542</u></a>	<b>Health Care and Human Services; Ways and Means</b> Allows private payers to hire home care workers through registry maintained by Home Care Commission.

<a href="#"><u>SB 1546</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Resolves terminology conflict to reflect that offense of endangering welfare of minor through distributing, selling or causing sale of tobacco to minor is Class A violation.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1547</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation; Ways and Means</b> Authorizes county governing bodies and small business employers to enter into agreements for reimbursement of portion of wages paid to youth employees.

<a href="#"><u>SB 1555</u></a>	<b>Rural Communities and Economic Development</b> Caps amount of bonds or other securities required of bidder or purchaser in connection with forest product sales by State Forester.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1556</u></a>	<b>Judiciary; Rules</b> Declares that person 21 years of age or older legally should be able to possess, transfer or produce marijuana.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1557</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Specifies when vehicle dealer has received certificate of title or other primary ownership document for purpose of offense of failure to provide clear title.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1558</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to pay compensation due to workers of members of certain decertified self-insured employer groups and to set standards by rule for proof of financial viability of self-insured employer and for insurance coverage retention and combined net worth of members of self-insured employer group.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1559</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Allows qualifying off-premises sales licensee to obtain endorsement authorizing sale of distilled liquor at licensed premises.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1560</u></a>	<b>Health Care and Human Services</b> Modifies requirements for health plan coverage of telemedical services.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1561</u></a>	<b>Health Care and Human Services</b> Exempts establishment where practitioner dispenses drugs from laws and rules related to regulation of drug outlets if establishment and practitioner meet certain criteria.

<a href="#"><u>SB 1571</u></a>	<b>General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection</b> Prohibits certain solicitation practices by construction contractors providing restoration work on residential or commercial property or contents following man-made or natural disaster.
<a href="#"><u>SB 1572</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Establishes standard for measuring distance between proposed or existing well and surface water source for purpose of determining probability or existence of impairment of, or substantial or undue interference with, existing rights of others to appropriate surface water.
