Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>HCR 202</u>	Rules Recognizes and honors Reserve Sergeant Scott Collins and Reserve Deputy Mark Whitehead for their service to this state.
<u>HJM 201</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Urges Congress to direct Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration to enhance safety standards for new and existing tank rail cars used to transport crude oil and other flammable liquids.
<u>HB 4007</u>	Education and Workforce Development Prohibits district school board from imposing time limitation on consent given to resident student to attend schools of another school district.
<u>HB 4011</u>	General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection Provides that city or county may not require precious metal secondhand dealer that is also pawnbroker to provide photograph of item of precious metal acquired in transaction.
<u>HB 4014</u>	General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection Provides that if insurer or supervising entity does not provide timely notice of termination, coverage under policy of portable electronics insurance continues despite enrolled customer's exhaustion of aggregate limit of liability until insurer or supervising entity provides notice of termination.
<u>HB 4021</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Directs public universities to charge nonresident veteran who is graduate student tuition and fees no greater than resident rate if nonresident veteran received either honorable discharge or general discharge under honorable conditions and provides proof of physical presence in Oregon within 12 months of enrollment.
<u>HB 4025</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Clarifies that maximum amount of home or farm loan made by Department of Veterans' Affairs to eligible individual applies to each loan.
<u>HB 4026</u>	Judiciary Requires providers of ignition interlock devices to notify agency or organization that conducted person's diagnostic assessment and person's defense attorney of record of any negative reports downloaded from ignition interlock device.
<u>HB 4039</u>	Finance and Revenue Provides exemption from ad valorem property taxation for property of nonprofit corporation that, for tax year beginning on July 1, 2012, was actually offered, occupied or used as low-income housing and granted exemption by county.
<u>HB 4051</u>	General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection Permits insurer, under specified conditions, to post insurance policy and endorsements on insurer's website in lieu of mailing or delivering insurance policy and endorsements to insured.
<u>HB 4052</u>	General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection Provides that electronic record that provides or delivers notice, offer, disclosure, document, form, correspondence, information or other communication required or permitted under insurance laws of this state satisfies requirement for provision or



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	availability to consumer in writing.
<u>HB 4057</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Directs certain boards and agencies to report to interim and statutory committees of Legislative Assembly by October 1, 2014, regarding implementation of new requirements to accept substantially equivalent military training or experience for certain education, experience or training requirements in order to obtain license, certificate or other authorization to practice profession.
<u>HB 4081</u>	Judiciary Specifies acts and practices of charitable organizations that are violations of law .
<u>HB 4094</u>	Judiciary Provides that person is immune from prosecution for offense of possession of alcohol by person under 21 years of age if person was in need of medical assistance due to alcohol consumption or if person sought medical assistance for another person in need of medical assistance due to alcohol consumption, and evidence of offense resulted from person's having sought or obtained medical assistance .
<u>HB 4104</u>	Business and Transportation Prohibits health benefit plan that provides coverage for injured worker from excluding, and requires plan to expedite, preauthorizations for medical services.
<u>HB 4114</u>	Judiciary Authorizes court to appoint protected person special advocate in protective proceeding at any time after appointment of fiduciary.
<u>HB 4148</u>	Finance and Revenue Changes interest rate accruing on deferred taxes under homestead property tax deferral program from six percent compounded annually to six percent per annum.
