Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SB 5701</u>	Ways and Means Adjusts biennial allocations of lottery moneys to Oregon Business Development Department.
<u>SB 5702</u>	Ways and Means Limits expenditures from federal funds collected or received by Department of Transportation for public safety broadband planning for six-year period beginning July 1, 2013.
<u>SB 5703</u>	Ways and Means Changes fund into which proceeds of certain lottery bonds are deposited for State Department of Energy.
<u>HB 4022</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Requires providers of radio communications service for cellular devices to provide, at request of law enforcement agency, call location information of cellular device used to place 9-1-1 call requesting emergency assistance or reasonably believed to be in possession of individual in emergency situation that involves risk of death or serious physical harm to individual.
<u>HB 4037</u>	Judiciary Authorizes county sheriff to designate county juvenile department or Oregon Youth Authority to provide direct transfer of juvenile offenders to youth correction facility as part of agreement with Department of Corrections or supervisory authority of county.
<u>HB 4042</u>	Rural Communities and Economic Development Adds renewable marine energy to types of energy for which availability of net metering is required.
<u>HB 4065</u>	General Government, Consumer and Small Business Protection Requires notice of trustee's sale in connection with foreclosure of residential property to include language that warns prospective purchasers that residential property may have been used in manufacturing methamphetamines.
<u>HB 4127</u>	Education and Workforce Development Requires that majority of members of Oregon Education Investment Board be public educational professionals who work, or have worked, on regular basis in public educational setting.
<u>HB 4139</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Requires Oregon State University, in consultation with State Department of Agriculture, to develop educational materials regarding best practices for avoiding adverse effects of pesticides on populations of bees and other pollinating insects.
<u>HB 4150</u>	Education and Workforce Development Revises assessment and grading system standards for school districts.
