Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>HB 4015</u>	Ways and Means Directs certain state agencies to use regional priorities for community and economic development in consideration of project funding decisions made in connection with grant, loan or incentive programs.
<u>HB 4019</u>	Ways and Means Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to annually identify federal or national entity that best provides information about affordability and value of institutions of higher education in Oregon.
<u>HB 4063</u>	Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Statutory Common School Fund Loans to identify opportunities for making loans from Common School Fund for purpose of financing projects that provide significant in-state economic benefits.
<u>HB 4066</u>	Ways and Means Authorizes Chief Justice of Supreme Court to establish reasonable fees for use of Oregon Judicial Case Information Network.
<u>HB 4087</u>	Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on School Safety.
<u>HB 4116</u>	Ways and Means Directs Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development and Higher Education Coordinating Commission to jointly establish grant program for purpose of distributing moneys to community colleges to increase number of underserved, low-income and first-generation college-bound students who enroll in community college and make progress toward degree or certificate.
<u>HB 4117</u>	Ways and Means Directs Department of Education to make grants to improve student achievement in certain schools that are high poverty and low performing.
<u>HB 4151</u>	Ways and Means Requires investigations of abuse of persons 65 years of age or older by Department of Human Services to be completed within 120 days from date of report of abuse except when concurrent criminal investigation is ongoing.
<u>HB 4154</u>	Ways and Means Requires Oregon Health Insurance Exchange Corporation to request federal agency to allow individuals and businesses to qualify for premium tax credits, cost-sharing reductions and business tax relief if individuals and businesses enrolled in qualified health plans directly with insurers.
