<u>SB 13</u>	Business and Transportation;Judiciary Authorizes law enforcement agencies to establish sobriety checkpoints.
<u>SB 18</u>	Health Care;Judiciary Removes antitrust exemption for coordinated care organizations.
<u>SB 19</u>	Workforce;Judiciary Establishes joint and several liability for person that aids or abets employer, contractor or subcontractor in violating certain wage rate statutes.
<u>SB 21</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Clean Air Fee or Tax Implementation to review results of report required by chapter 770, Oregon Laws 2013, and develop recommendations or proposals for options to implement clean air fee or tax to generate revenue.
<u>SB 22</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Ocean Acidification.
<u>SB 24</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Natural Resource Agency Consolidation.
<u>SB 72</u>	Health Care;Finance and Revenue Increases fees to take nursing examination and renew nursing license.
<u>SB 131</u>	Business and Transportation;Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on the Willamette Falls Navigation Canal and Locks.
<u>SB 134</u>	Rules;Ways and Means Establishes Oregon Investment Department as public investment agency to be supervised by director appointed by Oregon Investment Council.
<u>SB 149</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood;Judiciary Expands requirements for independent living that must be contained in case plans for children in custody of Department of Human Services.
<u>SB 159</u>	Ways and Means Revises procedures for preparation of Governor's budget.
<u>SB 161</u>	Judiciary;Finance and Revenue Authorizes county tax collector to transmit electronic notices of warrants for delinquent taxes on business personal property to Secretary of State for filing in Uniform Commercial Code (UCC) system.
<u>SB 187</u>	Education;Ways and Means Establishes task force to make recommendations regarding protection of privacy of students using education software.
<u>SB 202</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Requires establishment of Oregon Academy of Sciences as nonprofit corporation to serve as principal source of scientific investigation, examination and reporting on scientific questions referred to academy by Governor, Governor's designee or Legislative

<u>SB 208</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Recreational Placer and Suction Dredge Mining.
<u>SB 222</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood;Judiciary Extends sunset on provision authorizing Department of Human Services to appear as party in juvenile court proceeding without appearance of Attorney General.
<u>SB 228</u>	Health Care Increases fees and fee limits for registering tanning devices and X-ray machines and issuing specific licenses for sources of radiation.
<u>SB 229</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Requires members of Consumer Advisory Council who advise Director of Oregon Health Authority on provision of mental health services to be compensated by Oregon Health Authority for performing duties of council.
<u>SB 247</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Incrementally increases or establishes certain fees related to hunting, angling and commercial fishing over six-year period, applicable January 1, 2016, January 1, 2018, and January 1, 2020.
<u>SB 254</u>	Business and Transportation;Finance and Revenue Increases fee on motor vehicle fuel metering instrument or device in accordance with graduated schedule.
<u>SB 255</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Raises limit on fees for annual registration of animal remedy, veterinary biologic or pharmaceutical.
<u>SB 260</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Directs State Department of Energy by rule to establish and administer high performance schools program within clean energy deployment program to support energy efficiency and clean energy projects in public schools.
<u>SB 261</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Finance and Revenue Increases ballast water trip fee to \$88.
<u>SB 265</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds to finance implementation of Klamath Basin Restoration Agreement of 2010.
<u>SB 266</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Allows Water Resources Department to issue grants to assist recipient entities in preparation of place-based integrated water resources strategies.
<u>SB 268</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Creates task force for studying options for providing Water Resources Department with stable budget or increased revenues.

<u>SB 269</u>	Business and Transportation;Finance and Revenue Increases pilot registration fees.
<u>SB 271</u>	Business and Transportation Increases maximum rate of assessment paid by freight railroads operating in Oregon.
<u>SB 304</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Caps energy resource supplier assessment at ___ percent of supplier's gross operating revenue derived within this state in preceding calendar year.
<u>SB 306</u>	Business and Transportation;Ways and Means Permits Oregon Infrastructure Finance Authority to provide financial assistance for levee projects that contribute to improvement, expansion or repair of infrastructure systems and are essential for use or development of farm, industrial or commercial land.
<u>SB 322</u>	Education;Ways and Means Establishes funding mechanism for fifth year high school programs.
<u>SB 323</u>	Workforce Instructs Oregon Institute of Occupational Health Sciences to conduct study related to provision of medical services in workers' compensation claims.
<u>SB 329</u>	Business and Transportation;Ways and Means Increases annual fee imposed on public utilities and telecommunications providers for purpose of defraying costs of Public Utility Commission.
<u>SB 336</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority to establish parity in funding formula for school-based health centers.
<u>SB 337</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority to establish 11 new school-based health centers.
<u>SB 338</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for planning and administration necessary to accommodate new school-based health centers.
<u>SB 339</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Creates position of State School Nursing Consultant in Oregon Health Authority and specifies duties.
<u>SB 364</u>	Judiciary Requires court to use current classification of marijuana offenses when determining if person is eligible for order setting aside conviction.
<u>SB 397</u>	Judiciary;Finance and Revenue Increases fees for driving while under influence of intoxicants screening interview and diagnostic assessment.
<u>SB 398</u>	Judiciary;Finance and Revenue Requires providers of ignition interlock devices to notify court that required device to be installed of any negative reports downloaded from ignition interlock device.

<u>SB 405</u>	Judiciary;Ways and Means Creates Task Force on Juvenile Court Records.
<u>SB 408</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness;Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Military Department for Oregon Military Museum.
<u>SB 410</u>	Rules Requires cochairs of Joint Committee on Ways and Means to serve as cochairs of Joint Legislative Audit Committee.
<u>SB 416</u>	Health Care;Finance and Revenue Requires payment of fee for smoke shop certification, renewal of smoke shop certification, transfer of smoke shop certification and relocation of smoke shop.
<u>SB 417</u>	Business and Transportation Requires premises where person makes retail sales of tobacco products and inhalant delivery systems to be licensed by Oregon Liquor Control Commission.
<u>SB 423</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Directs Water Resources Commission to study issue of standing in lawsuits relating to water.
<u>SB 428</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Makes housekeeping changes to statutes relating to alcohol and drug treatment.
<u>SB 432</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Requires moneys in Emergency Communications Account, including Enhanced 9-1-1 Subaccount, to be used for purposes of 9-1-1 emergency communications unless statutory exception is made during state of fiscal emergency.
<u>SB 434</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness;Finance and Revenue Grants higher property tax exemption on property of veterans with service-connected disabilities of 100 percent.
<u>SB 439</u>	Education;Ways and Means Establishes Outdoor Education Account for purpose of providing outdoor school programs.
<u>SB 441</u>	Business and Transportation;Ways and Means Authorizes Trust for Cultural Development Board to solicit and accept gifts, bequests or devises of money, securities or other property.
<u>SB 446</u>	Judiciary;Ways and Means Provides for annual adjustment of judges' salaries based on Consumer Price Index.
<u>SB 447</u>	Education;Ways and Means Establishes grant program to provide matching fund grants to school districts for capital costs of school districts.
<u>SB 450</u>	Education;Ways and Means Increases weight allotted for children in poverty for purposes of State School Fund distributions.

<u>SB 451</u>	Rules;Ways and Means Establishes prudent maximum amount of outstanding General Fund-supported debt as amount for which debt service due in biennium equals five percent of General Fund revenues estimated to be received in biennium.
<u>SB 468</u>	Workforce;Judiciary Authorizes Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to issue warrants for collection of certain debts owed to bureau.
<u>SB 472</u>	Business and Transportation;Finance and Revenue Increases maximum number of Pacific Wonderland registration plates that may be issued.
<u>SB 478</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish and maintain list of designated high priority chemicals of concern for children's health used in children's products and to periodically review and revise list.
<u>SB 479</u>	Implementing Measure 91;Ways and Means Creates Task Force on Clinical Research of Cannabis and directs task force to study and report on development of medical cannabis industry that provides patients with medical products that meet individual patient needs.
<u>SB 480</u>	Implementing Measure 91;Ways and Means Establishes as semi-independent state agency Clinical Research of Cannabis Board.
