Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SJR 14</u>	Finance and Revenue Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution providing that surpluses of personal income tax revenues in excess of two percent of forecast revenues are equally deposited in reserve fund established by law and returned to personal income taxpayers.
<u>SJR 15</u>	Finance and Revenue Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to establish land-value lease fee imposed on real market value of land with proceeds distributed pro rata to residents of state.
<u>SB 533</u>	Business and Transportation Permits motorcycle driver to proceed at stop light under certain conditions.
<u>SB 546</u>	Business and Transportation Requires use of headlights when windshield wipers are on.
<u>SB 547</u>	Health Care Creates nurse emeritus license to permit certain retired nurses to engage in volunteer practice of nursing.
<u>SB 548</u>	Business and Transportation Authorizes county to sell or donate real property to certain federally recognized Indian tribes.
<u>SB 549</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Allows nonconforming public or private school on land zoned for exclusive farm use to expand on contiguous land acquired by school after school became nonconforming.
<u>SB 550</u>	Workforce Exempts retired member of Public Employees Retirement System from limitations on reemployment if member is reemployed by fire department or rural fire protection district that serves population of fewer than 15,000 residents.
<u>SB 551</u>	Business and Transportation Requires registration of bicycles.
<u>SB 552</u>	Workforce Establishes certain workplace protections for domestic workers.
<u>SB 553</u>	Education Imposes limits on instances when student under 12 years of age may be suspended or expelled from school.
<u>SB 554</u>	Education Directs Department of Education to assist school districts in achieving specified goals related to school discipline.
<u>SB 555</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Requires qualified nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities to pay at least minimum wage or prevailing rate of wage set forth in state or federal law to individuals with disabilities.

Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SB 556</u>	Education Prohibits use of expulsion to address truancy.
<u>SB 557</u>	Judiciary Modifies scope of justifiable use of physical force for purposes of criminal prosecution.
<u>SB 558</u>	Health Care Requires health benefit plan to reimburse cost of pharmacist consultation that meets specified criteria.
<u>SB 559</u>	Business and Transportation Requires Department of Corrections to adopt rules that prohibit department's correctional facilities from having contract with provider of telephone services under which department or facility receives payment for telephone services provided to inmates of facility.
<u>SB 560</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Establishes timelines by which evaluations must be completed to determine eligibility for special education.
<u>SB 561</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Directs Department of Human Services to submit report to interim legislative committees no later than July 1, 2016, regarding occurrences of suicide and status of suicide prevention efforts in Oregon.
<u>SB 562</u>	Education Establishes Oregon Empowerment Scholarship Program for purpose of providing options in education to students of this state.
<u>SB 563</u>	Judiciary Requires law enforcement agencies to submit to Attorney General report stating number of untested sexual assault evidence collection kits in possession of law enforcement agency and date on which evidence was collected.
<u>SB 564</u>	Health Care Specifies that personally identifiable information may not be reported to Oregon Health Authority for purposes related to collecting data related to cancer and benign tumors of brain and central nervous system.
<u>SB 565</u>	Finance and Revenue Creates tax credit for certified historic property rehabilitation contributions.
<u>SB 566</u>	Finance and Revenue;Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Data Centers.
<u>SB 567</u>	Finance and Revenue Requires interest on moneys in General Fund to be deposited into Oregon Rainy Day Fund.
<u>SB 568</u>	Finance and Revenue;Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on the Taxation of Intangible Property.

<u>SB 569</u>	Finance and Revenue Broadens types of communications services on which municipalities may impose privilege tax.
<u>SB 572</u>	Rules Requires state to pay for postage prepaid return identification envelopes provided to electors for each primary, general or statewide special election.
<u>SB 573</u>	Finance and Revenue; Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Land Value Taxation to compare methods of property taxation.
<u>SB 574</u>	Business and Transportation Requires person providing restoration work on residential or small commercial structure following man-made or natural disaster to have appropriate license endorsement issued by Construction Contractors Board.
<u>SB 575</u>	Judiciary Requires police officer to inform person stopped for traffic violation or upon suspicion of criminal activity that person has right to refuse request to search.
<u>SB 576</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Makes case planning and placement decisions for wards in custody of Department of Human Services responsibility of case planning committee convened by department and composed of relevant parties and stakeholders with interest in ward's welfare, case planning and placement.
<u>SB 577</u>	Judiciary; Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Justice for various public safety purposes in support of rural or fiscally distressed counties.
