Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SB 578</u>	Business and Transportation Permits insurer, under specified conditions, to post insurance policy and endorsements on insurer's website in lieu of mailing or delivering insurance policy and endorsements to insured.
<u>SB 579</u>	Workforce Requires state contracting agency that awards public improvement contract with contract price of more than \$5 million to require contractor to employ apprentices to perform 10 percent of work hours on public improvement that workers in apprenticeable occupations perform.
<u>SB 580</u>	Business and Transportation Allows State Landscape Contractors Board to assess contested case proceeding costs to person requesting that claim filed against board licensee be resolved through contested case proceeding.
<u>SB 581</u>	Business and Transportation Changes fee for application for or renewal of permit to practice public accountancy.
<u>SB 582</u>	Business and Transportation Removes requirement that credit union apply and pay fee to Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services in order to open additional places of business.
<u>SB 583</u>	Business and Transportation Allows brewery-public house licensee to also hold off-premises sales license under certain circumstances.
<u>SB 584</u>	Workforce Directs public contracting agency to suspend right of certified disadvantaged minority, women or emerging small business enterprise to bid on or participate in public contract if certified disadvantaged minority, women or emerging small business enterprise fails to perform commercially useful function in public contract.
<u>SB 585</u>	Workforce Establishes State Apprenticeship Education and Training Fund and continuously appropriates moneys in fund to State Apprenticeship and Training Council and Bureau of Labor and Industries for specified purposes.
<u>SB 586</u>	Workforce Increases age of youth for whom Youth Development Council may oversee unified system of services from 20 years to 24 years.
<u>SB 587</u>	Education; Finance and Revenue Adjusts manner in which attendance is calculated for purposes of State School Fund distributions.
<u>SB 588</u>	Education Allows school district and public charter school to be considered single legal entity for purpose of public charter school law if public charter school is only school in school district and other conditions are met.

<u>SB 589</u>	Judiciary Amplifies materials that may be considered legislative history of statute.
<u>SB 590</u>	Judiciary Directs court to appoint court visitor for minor respondent in guardianship proceeding where minor is more than 16 years of age and court determines there is likelihood that petition seeking guardianship of respondent as adult will be filed before respondent attains age of majority or as adult.
<u>SB 591</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Establishes public policy that Department of Human Services employee whose employment is terminated for violating duty to report abuse is not eligible for reinstatement of employment with department.
<u>SB 592</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Repeals law that prevents local governments from imposing conditions on approved permits that effectively establish sales price for residential development or limit purchase to class or group of purchasers.
<u>SB 593</u>	Judiciary Permits party that requested name change in proceeding for marital annulment, dissolution or separation to request entry of supplemental judgment or corrected judgment when court does not order name change in general judgment.
<u>SB 594</u>	Health Care Provides that health care practitioner is not required to submit credentialing information to Oregon Health Authority for purposes related to credentialing program until occurrence of certain events, including passage of date by which authority by rule requires that type of health care practitioner to submit credentialing information to authority.
<u>SB 595</u>	Health Care Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to impose civil penalties on credentialing organizations and health care practitioners who violate laws and rules governing credentialing program administered by authority.
<u>SB 596</u>	Business and Transportation Requires person employing, contracting with or leasing services of construction flagger to obtain construction flagging contractor license.
<u>SB 597</u>	Workforce Increases Oregon minimum wage rate in graduated steps to \$13.50 per hour by 2017.
<u>SB 598</u>	Workforce Establishes Task Force on 21st Century Apprenticeship with 14 members appointed by President of Senate, Speaker of House of Representatives and Governor.
