<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>SJR 18</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution directing Legislative Assembly to establish education support fund consisting of revenues from sales tax imposed at rate not to exceed ___ percent.
<a href="#"><u>SJR 19</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require bills declaring emergency to receive at least two-thirds vote of all members elected to each house for passage.
<a href="#"><u>SB 643</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Establishes Kindergarten Through Grade Three Reading Initiative Program to assist school districts in implementing early reading literacy programs.
<a href="#"><u>SB 644</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Requires public body, except special district, to reserve one percent of appropriation for constructing, reconstructing or renovating park or public building for purpose of renovating or improving existing park or public building to meet current accessibility standards for persons with disabilities that are promulgated under Americans with Disabilities Act and regulations adopted under Act.
<a href="#"><u>SB 645</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Creates defense to charge of prostitution for person under 18 years of age.
<a href="#"><u>SB 646</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Creates defense to charge of prostitution for person under 18 years of age.
<a href="#"><u>SB 647</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for Community College Support Fund for distribution to community colleges and community college service districts.
<a href="#"><u>SB 648</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Expands duties of Central Oregon Health Council.
<a href="#"><u>SB 649</u></a>	<b>Workforce</b> Modifies definitions of "compensable injury" and "preexisting condition" for purposes of workers' compensation claims.
<a href="#"><u>SB 650</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Establishes Oregon Universal Savings Account Board to create and maintain Oregon Universal Savings Account Program.
<a href="#"><u>SB 651</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Requires that candidate for state Senate or state Representative receive majority of votes cast in general election to be elected.
<a href="#"><u>SB 652</u></a>	<b>Finance and Revenue</b> Establishes personal income tax credit of \$250 per dependent child.

<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>SB 654</u></a>	<b>Workforce;Tax Credits</b> Creates income tax credit for certain employers that provide paid family leave, with restrictions.
<a href="#"><u>SB 655</u></a>	<b>Workforce;Tax Credits</b> Increases amount of working family child care credit by doubling applicable percentage of taxpayer's child care expenses allowed as credit.
<a href="#"><u>SB 656</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Requires political parties to file organizational documents with Secretary of State setting forth organizational procedures.
<a href="#"><u>SB 657</u></a>	<b>Education;Ways and Means</b> Appropriates moneys to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for 2015 biennium for agricultural experiment station and branch station, Oregon State University Extension Service and Forest Research Laboratory programs of Oregon State University.
<a href="#"><u>SB 658</u></a>	<b>Finance and Revenue</b> Allows owners of land in Portland that was disqualified from western Oregon forestland special assessment for property tax year beginning on July 1, 2011, to request directly from State Fish and Wildlife Commission designation of land as eligible for wildlife habitat special assessment.
<a href="#"><u>SB 659</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Requires that minor child be considered resident in determining eligibility for home and community-based care if child lives at least six weeks each year with parent residing in this state.
<a href="#"><u>SB 660</u></a>	<b>Health Care;Ways and Means</b> Directs Oregon Health Authority to develop program for screening students in this state who are susceptible to tooth decay and providing dental sealants for those students.
<a href="#"><u>SB 661</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Requires health benefit plan that covers opioid analgesic drug products to cover abuse-deterrent opioid analgesic drug products, at no greater cost to insured than other preferred drugs under plan, and specifies other requirements regarding coverage.
<a href="#"><u>SB 662</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Requires that dental instructor's license issued to specialist be restricted to specialty for which applicant completed advanced dental education program.
<a href="#"><u>SB 663</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Changes governmental framework for conducting public health activities in this state and for providing public health services to residents of this state.
<a href="#"><u>SB 664</u></a>	<b>Workforce;Finance and Revenue</b> Allows for additional weights in State School Fund distributions for students who are enrolled in and earn three or more credits for courses that are part of approved career and technical education program.
<a href="#"><u>SB 665</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Creates Hospital Rate Commission in Oregon Health Authority to review hospital charges billed by certain hospitals and recommend to Oregon Health Authority whether to approve

	charges as reasonable based on prescribed criteria.
<a href="#"><u>SB 666</u></a>	<b>Finance and Revenue</b> Requires that offer of just compensation for condemned property may not be less than real market value of property as determined by county assessor or Department of Revenue.
<a href="#"><u>SB 667</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Removes sunset related to grants distributed to small school districts with one or more small high schools.
<a href="#"><u>SB 668</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Provides that right and privilege to construct, maintain or operate water, gas, electric or communication service line, fixture or other facility along public roads, free of charge, does not extend to county roads.
<a href="#"><u>SB 669</u></a>	<b>Finance and Revenue</b> Establishes personal income tax credit for contributions to charitable organizations.
<a href="#"><u>SB 670</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Directs Department of Justice to develop training curriculum and provide training to public employees, community providers and others on confidentiality requirements, privacy laws and sharing of information in order to consistently facilitate sharing of information between programs and entities wherever feasible.
<a href="#"><u>SB 671</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to transfer ownership of certain real property to City of Pendleton.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2036</u></a>	<b>Veterans and Emergency Preparedness</b> Provides that U.S. Highway 395 shall be known as World War I Veterans Memorial Highway.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2226</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Expands definition of "victim" to include estate, successor in interest, trust and other specified parties for purpose of ordering restitution in criminal case.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2335</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Revises definition of "enter or remain unlawfully" for purposes of crimes of burglary and criminal trespass.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2372</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Requires that police officer be certified by Department of Public Safety Standards and Training rather than Board on Public Safety Standards and Training before officer may request urine test of person arrested for offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2380</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Authorizes court in post-conviction relief proceeding, upon joint motion of parties, to vacate judgment or order and remand proceeding to circuit court to reconsider judgment or order.

<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>HB 2433</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Provides that electronically filed criminal citation may be of different format or size than uniform citation.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2461</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Allows Department of State Lands by rule to provide for additional exemptions to leasing requirements relating to submersible lands.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2462</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Requires Department of State Lands to maintain electronic documentation rather than paper copies of deeds and conveyances belonging to state.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2661</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Provides that school drills and instruction on safety threats include lockdown procedures.
