<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>SCR 7</u></a>	<b>Veterans and Emergency Preparedness</b> Recognizes and honors Specialist John Alexander Pelham (1991-2014) for his service to his country.
<a href="#"><u>SJM 9</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Urges Congress to expedite appropriation of funds to monitor and prevent spread of aquatic invasive species and implement Water Resources Reform and Development Act.
<a href="#"><u>SR 3</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Honors 2014 Heisman Trophy winner Marcus Mariota.
<a href="#"><u>SR 4</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Honors 1962 Heisman Trophy winner Terry Baker.
<a href="#"><u>SB 687</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Requires that candidate for United States Senator, Representative in Congress, Secretary of State, State Treasurer, Attorney General, Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries, judge, state Senator or state Representative receive majority of votes cast in general election to be elected.
<a href="#"><u>SB 688</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Removes sunset on authority of institution of higher education to sponsor public charter school.
<a href="#"><u>SB 689</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Removes sunset on provisions that allow students whose legal residence is not within school district to attend school in district as resident if student receives written consent.
<a href="#"><u>SB 690</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Eliminates daylight saving time adjustment to standard of time for State of Oregon.
<a href="#"><u>SB 692</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Removes sunset on ability of Oregon Health Authority to approve dental pilot projects.
<a href="#"><u>SB 693</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Authorizes scrap metal business to make payment by electronic funds transfer or stored value device.
<a href="#"><u>SB 694</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Allows operators of motorcycles and mopeds to pass vehicles in same lane during traffic jams or slowdowns.
<a href="#"><u>SB 697</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Prohibits Department of Transportation, counties and cities from using more than five percent of moneys appropriated from State Highway Fund to cover administrative costs.
<a href="#"><u>SB 700</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood;Ways and Means</b> Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for Senior Farm Direct Nutrition Program and Women, Infants and Children Farm Direct Nutrition Program.

<a href="#"><u>SB 702</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Specifies that aggregate total of hours worked by part-time faculty member at more than one public institution of higher education shall be considered in determination of full-time status of faculty member for health care coverage.
<a href="#"><u>SB 703</u></a>	<b>Education;Finance and Revenue</b> Adjusts methods by which State School Fund distributions are made to school districts for students enrolled in English as a second language program.
<a href="#"><u>SB 704</u></a>	<b>Education;Finance and Revenue</b> Allows for additional weights in state school fund distributions for historically underserved students who have made specified progress in ninth grade.
<a href="#"><u>SB 705</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Directs Oregon Health Authority to study and report on demolition of residential structures that have been painted with lead-based paint or insulated with asbestos and risks to public health associated with such demolitions.
<a href="#"><u>SB 706</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Repeals provision for award of damages to Department of Revenue for frivolous claim, defense or argument made by taxpayer.
<a href="#"><u>SB 707</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Eliminates primary election as nominating election for major political party candidates.
<a href="#"><u>SB 708</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Directs State Board of Education to include textbooks and other instructional materials on explicit phonics on statewide list of textbooks and other instructional materials.
<a href="#"><u>SB 709</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Modifies provisions to allow students who are not residents of school district to attend school of school district.
<a href="#"><u>SB 710</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Requires state health plans, health insurers, health care providers or health care clearinghouses to provide, upon request, one copy of individually identifiable health information free of charge to individual, or to specified representative, when individual is requesting Social Security disability benefits or contesting denial of Social Security disability benefits.
<a href="#"><u>SB 711</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Requires that public bodies develop and implement policies for securely removing personal information from digital data storage devices and other electronic data storage devices owned by public body, leased by public body or otherwise under control of public body before selling, donating, recycling or otherwise disposing of device.
<a href="#"><u>SB 712</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Changes water management and conservation plan approval condition for extension of time to develop permit for municipal use of water.

<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>SB 713</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Prohibits motor vehicle manufacturer, distributor or importer from requiring dealer to advertise, promote, offer or sell extended service contracts, extended maintenance plans, or similar products or services that manufacturer, distributor or importer provides, originates, sponsors or endorses.
<a href="#"><u>SB 714</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Prevents motor vehicle manufacturer, distributor or importer from taking certain adverse actions against motor vehicle dealer because dealer sold motor vehicle to customer that exported motor vehicle or resold motor vehicle for export.
<a href="#"><u>SB 715</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Permits travel retailers that are not licensed insurance producers to offer travel insurance at direction of licensed insurance producers, subject to certain restrictions.
<a href="#"><u>SB 716</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Authorizes Clackamas, Multnomah and Washington Counties each to designate one large-lot industrial reserve of 150 to 500 acres.
<a href="#"><u>SB 717</u></a>	<b>Veterans and Emergency Preparedness</b> Directs Department of Transportation to erect and maintain Fallen Hero roadside memorial sign for John Pelham.
<a href="#"><u>SB 718</u></a>	<b>Workforce</b> Defines "wages" for certain wage claims.
<a href="#"><u>SB 719</u></a>	<b>Workforce</b> Includes payments due for accrued vacation time and personal time off in meaning of wages for purposes of wage claim.
<a href="#"><u>SB 720</u></a>	<b>Workforce</b> Authorizes county governing bodies and small business employers to enter into agreements for reimbursement of portion of wages paid to youth employees.
<a href="#"><u>SB 777</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood; Finance and Revenue</b> Directs State Treasurer to establish by rule qualified state program as described in federal Stephen Beck, Jr., Achieving a Better Life Experience Act of 2014.
<a href="#"><u>HCR 6</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Honors William "Bill Kitt" Kittredge for his role as influential leader in early years of Oregon's statehood.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2206</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Renames crime of patronizing a prostitute to commercial sexual solicitation.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2294</u></a>	<b>Health Care; Ways and Means</b> Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish Oregon Health Information Technology program.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2331</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Provides when interests of beneficiaries vest.

<a href="#"><u>HB 2332</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Permits parties to judgment that contains spousal support award to request required exchange of certain documents without filing request for modification of judgment with court.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2431</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Requires physical examination for candidates for Oregon State Police to be physical examination consistent with rules adopted by Department of State Police.
