Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SB 695</u>	Health Care Repeals sunset on authorization for Oregon Health Authority to contract with prepaid managed care health services organization to provide care to medical assistance recipients.
<u>SB 696</u>	Health Care Directs Oregon Health Authority to study need for changes in licensure of health care practitioners that treat individuals diagnosed with autism spectrum disorders and report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health care on or before September 15, 2015.
<u>SB 698</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Creates position of State School Nursing Consultant in Oregon Health Authority and specifies duties.
<u>SB 699</u>	Business and Transportation Broadens exemption to provisions regulating cosmetology disciplines for persons who prepare individual's hair solely for professional photograph or theatrical performance.
<u>HCR 7</u>	Rules Honors Oregon pioneer, author and activist, Abigail Scott Duniway.
<u>HB 2175</u>	Rules Deletes requirement that state agencies file with Division of Audits of Secretary of State documentation regarding transmittal of certain state funds to State Treasurer.
<u>HB 2330</u>	Business and Transportation Allows business entities that convert to or merge with other business entities to specify location of plan of conversion or plan of merger and to provide copy of plan of conversion or plan of merger upon request and at no cost to owners, in lieu of including plan of conversion or plan of merger with articles of conversion or articles of merger that are filed with Secretary of State.
<u>HB 2430</u>	Judiciary Authorizes Department of State Police and State Fire Marshal to accept and distribute gifts, grants, donations and funds from any source, including services and property, to carry out duties of department or marshal.
<u>HB 2482</u>	Finance and Revenue Requires Department of Revenue to appraise industrial property if improvements have real market value of more than \$1 million, unless appraisal delegated to county upon request of county assessor.
<u>HB 2549</u>	Judiciary Allows state agency to decline to assign debt of estate to private collection agency if Department of Revenue has notice that estate has closed.
