<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>SB 732</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Creates offense of selling tobacco products or tobacco product devices to person under 21 years of age.
<a href="#"><u>SB 738</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Provides that criminal defendants do not lose right to vote as result of incarceration.
<a href="#"><u>SB 739</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Establishes standards of care for Department of Corrections inmates with serious mental illness.
<a href="#"><u>SB 755</u></a>	<b>Implementing Measure 91</b> Restricts amount of cannabinoid products that medical marijuana facility may transfer during 24-hour period to registry identification cardholder or cardholder's designated primary caregiver.
<a href="#"><u>SB 756</u></a>	<b>Judiciary; Implementing Measure 91</b> Modifies offense of smoking in motor vehicle to clarify that offense applies to smoking marijuana and use of electronic cigarette to vaporize cannabinoid solutions.
<a href="#"><u>SB 774</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Creates task force to investigate expanding authority of Home Care Commission to provide services to home care workers.
<a href="#"><u>SB 780</u></a>	<b>Veterans and Emergency Preparedness</b> Directs Department of Corrections to establish pilot program for mental health treatment for inmates engaged in intensive alternative incarceration addiction program who are servicemembers and who have been diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder.
<a href="#"><u>SB 781</u></a>	<b>Veterans and Emergency Preparedness</b> Permits Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to exempt association with membership composed of current or former members of Armed Forces of United States from operation of Insurance Code and to require association to submit certain information to director.
<a href="#"><u>SB 790</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Requires Department of Justice to encourage and support services, programs and curricula to educate and inform students in grades 7 through 12 about domestic violence.
<a href="#"><u>SB 797</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Defines "vapor products." Amends laws related to use of tobacco products by minors to include use of vapor products by minors, including crime of endangering welfare of minor and other criminal offenses and civil penalties related to use or acquisition of tobacco products by minor.
<a href="#"><u>SB 823</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Restricts vehicle idling and expands types of vehicles that are required to comply with idling restrictions.
<a href="#"><u>SB 831</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Requires coordinated care organization to employ or contract with clinical mental health professionals to provide mental health care and treatment to members of organization.

<a href="#"><u>SB 832</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Requires Oregon Health Authority to provide grants for integrating mental health and physical health services to coordinated care organizations that meet standards prescribed by authority.
<a href="#"><u>SB 866</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Limits state governmental appropriations for general governmental purposes in biennium to lesser of percentage increase in projected personal income, percentage increase in projected population growth plus inflation or percentage increase in projected gross domestic product of Oregon for biennium.
<a href="#"><u>SB 868</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means</b> Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Fish and Wildlife for biennial expenses.
<a href="#"><u>SB 873</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Modifies authority to site or modify certain utility facilities on land zoned for exclusive farm use.
<a href="#"><u>SB 885</u></a>	<b>Workforce</b> Provides that moneys received by Lane County from federal forest reserves shall be used to fund career and technical education in county.
<a href="#"><u>SB 886</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Transfers authority over health care facility structure plan review and inspections for fire and life safety from State Fire Marshal to Department of Consumer and Business Services or to municipalities having building inspection programs.
<a href="#"><u>SB 887</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Extends enrollment period for solar energy pilot programs for retail electricity consumers to March 31, 2020.
<a href="#"><u>SB 888</u></a>	<b>Workforce</b> Authorizes employee of certain employers to request flexible or predictable work schedule.
<a href="#"><u>SB 889</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Allows person to file motion or petition seeking to assert right of public access to court document or proceeding.
<a href="#"><u>SB 890</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood;Ways and Means</b> Establishes Two Generational Approach to Success Task Force.
<a href="#"><u>SB 891</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Requires health care facilities to publish, in manner prescribed by Oregon Health Authority, price data regarding health care services offered.
<a href="#"><u>SB 892</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Requires Oregon Health Authority to adopt procedures to facilitate coordinated care organization assisting member of organization with renewal of eligibility for medical assistance.

<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>SB 893</u></a>	<b>Workforce</b> Requires one-time election by governing body of local government to offer alternative benefit plan after participating in plan offered by Oregon Educators Benefit Board or Public Employees' Benefit Board to be made within 30 days of third anniversary of date on which governing body first elected to participate in benefit plan offered by board.
<a href="#"><u>SB 894</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Requires health insurance policies or certificates that include prescription drug benefits, health benefit plans and the state medical assistance program to cover costs of specified women's health care drugs and services.
<a href="#"><u>SB 895</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Requires schools and children's facilities to make available certain information related to immunizations.
<a href="#"><u>SB 896</u></a>	<b>Education;Finance and Revenue</b> Increases threshold under which school district may receive additional State School Fund moneys for student eligible for special education.
<a href="#"><u>SB 897</u></a>	<b>Education;Finance and Revenue</b> Limits additional distributions of State School Fund moneys to school districts for students enrolled in English as a second language program to no more than seven school years for each student.
<a href="#"><u>SB 898</u></a>	<b>Education;Finance and Revenue</b> Directs Department of Education to award grants to school districts for support service programs, education innovation programs and education intervention programs.
<a href="#"><u>SB 899</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to revoke license or registration, or right to apply for license or registration, if person has been dismissed for cause two or more times.
<a href="#"><u>SB 900</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Requires Oregon Health Authority to be responsible for posting to its website health care price data for inpatient and outpatient hospital services.
<a href="#"><u>SB 901</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Requires insurer to reimburse providers directly for medical, surgical and nursing services provided to insured.
<a href="#"><u>SB 903</u></a>	<b>Finance and Revenue</b> Repeals sunset of law authorizing only school districts to impose construction taxes.
<a href="#"><u>SB 904</u></a>	<b>Judiciary;Ways and Means</b> Establishes Joint Legislative Committee on Privacy and Civil Liberties Oversight.
<a href="#"><u>SB 905</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Adds physician assistant to Oregon Medical Board membership.
<a href="#"><u>SB 906</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Directs Department of Transportation to provide for issuance of titles and identification

	plates for Class I, Class III and Class IV all-terrain vehicles.
<a href="#"><u>SB 907</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Requires driver of vehicle involved in accident resulting only in damage to fixtures or property legally upon or adjacent to highway to provide notice to owner of property within one business day of accident.
<a href="#"><u>SB 908</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Removes prohibition of filing motion to set aside conviction for person committing certain offenses within previous 10 years.
<a href="#"><u>SB 909</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Requires that fitness determination be conducted before hiring individuals with specified criminal history if individual will have direct contact with resident of residential facility or adult foster home or persons who receive in-home services or supports.
<a href="#"><u>SB 910</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Directs law enforcement agency to notify Attorney General when police officer's use of deadly physical force causes death of person.
<a href="#"><u>SB 911</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Directs Department of Justice to conduct study on deadly use of force by police and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2016.
<a href="#"><u>SB 912</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Creates temporal distinction between "historically filled lands" and "new lands" for purposes of determining ownership and transfer of ownership of lands created upon submersible or submerged lands by artificial fill or deposit.
<a href="#"><u>SB 913</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Creates offense of trafficking in animal parts.
<a href="#"><u>SB 914</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Eliminates automatic reporting of person found to have committed act that would constitute felony sex crime if committed by adult.
<a href="#"><u>SB 915</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Authorizes persons adjudicated for sex crime as juvenile in Oregon to file petition for relief from reporting requirements when person does not reside, attend school or work in Oregon.
<a href="#"><u>SB 916</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Directs Oregon Medical Board and Oregon State Board of Nursing to adopt rules regarding diagnosis and treatment of Lyme disease.
<a href="#"><u>SB 917</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Excludes disability income insurance from definition of health insurance in Insurance Code.
