Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>HCR 11</u>	Rules Honors Ramona Line for decades of service as Chief Clerk of Oregon House of Representatives.
<u>HB 2007</u>	Workforce Makes imposition of disciplinary action against employee that inquires about or discloses wage information unlawful employment practice.
<u>HB 2213</u>	Workforce Includes employees of Department of Corrections who have direct contact with inmates in category of employees for which on-the-job safety issues are employment relations issues subject to collective bargaining.
<u>HB 2225</u>	Judiciary Authorizes circuit court judge to authorize execution of search warrant outside judicial district of court for search related to certain offenses involving victim 65 years of age or older.
<u>HB 2333</u>	Judiciary;Ways and Means Clarifies that certain statutes of limitation are tolled if person entitled to bring action is child or is insane.
<u>HB 2383</u>	Finance and Revenue Requires telephonic seller that solicits purchase of business opportunity to make certain disclosures before completing transaction.
<u>HB 2404</u>	Education Adjusts school food and beverage nutritional standards to comply with federal food and beverage nutritional standards.
<u>HB 2408</u>	Education Changes name of Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development to Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development.
<u>HB 2442</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Changes name of State Housing Council to Oregon Housing Stability Council.
<u>HB 2444</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Revises statutes relating to mediation of agricultural disputes.
<u>HB 2456</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Modifies optional process for evaluation of changes to urban growth boundary of city outside Metro with population of 10,000 or more.
<u>HB 2481</u>	Business and Transportation Establishes filing fee for appealing board of stewards ruling to Oregon Racing Commission.
<u>HB 2488</u>	Finance and Revenue Replaces penalty for taxpayer's substantial understatement of taxable income with penalty for substantial understatement of net tax.

<u>HB 2490</u>	Finance and Revenue Changes to August 31 end date for annual indexing of maximum aggregate amount that local government official or tribal government official may place in investment pool in custody of State Treasurer.
<u>HB 2493</u>	Finance and Revenue Modifies meeting schedule of State Debt Policy Advisory Commission, requiring that meetings be held at least annually.
<u>HB 2501</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Requires that annual report by State Forester to Emergency Board include private property loss information for fires of 1,000 acres or more.
<u>HB 2544</u>	Workforce Requires issue subject to collective bargaining during term of collective bargaining agreement that is not resolved through negotiation or mediation to be resolved through binding arbitration.
<u>HB 2546</u>	Health Care Defines "inhalant delivery system." Amends laws concerning sale of tobacco products to, and use of tobacco products by, minors so those laws equally apply to inhalant delivery systems.
