<u>SB 8</u>	Judiciary Increases statute of limitations for certain sex crimes to within 20 years after commission of crime.
<u>SB 902</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Revives section 1, chapter 598, Oregon Laws 2013.
<u>SB 919</u>	Judiciary Provides that person who falsely reports hazardous substance, fire, explosion, catastrophe or other emergency in court facility or public building commits crime of disorderly conduct in the first degree.
<u>SB 920</u>	Health Care Makes legislative findings regarding provision of antibiotics and its relation to public health.
<u>SB 921</u>	Business and Transportation Directs Department of Transportation to make efforts to complete installation of median barriers between opposing lanes of travel on interstate highways in certain circumstances.
<u>SB 922</u>	Business and Transportation Provides that reimbursement to member of legal expense organization for charges that member incurs for legal services does not include nominal fee for operating expenses that legal expense organization incurs or pays to providing attorney.
<u>HCR 5</u>	Rules Honors Coach Daniel J. "Danny" Miles for his career and achievements.
<u>HJM 6</u>	Health Care Urges Congress to take steps to ease shortage of primary care physicians in Oregon.
<u>HB 2230</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness; Ways and Means Requires Director of Oregon Health Authority to notify Director of Veterans' Affairs upon receipt of certain written information from member or veteran of uniformed service, if authorized to do so by member or veteran.
<u>HB 2340</u>	Judiciary Limits personal information that may be included in certain judgments, orders and other court documents.
<u>HB 2362</u>	Judiciary Requires court to give greatest consideration to benefit to person who is subject of protective proceeding by party's actions in proceeding when determining whether to award attorney fees.
<u>HB 2363</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Requires treating physician to document in clinical record any seclusion of person alleged to have mental illness who is confined in hospital or nonhospital facility.
<u>HB 2368</u>	Health Care Provides that if person has both valid health care instruction, or valid power of attorney for health care, and declaration for mental health treatment, that inconsistencies in

	documents are governed by declaration for mental health treatment.
<u>HB 2377</u>	Judiciary Prohibits person from soliciting, requesting or otherwise inducing another person to provide personal information by representing or implying that person is third person, without third person's knowledge, authorization and consent.
<u>HB 2439</u>	Workforce Requires request to reopen hearing upon claim to be filed with Office of Administrative Hearings with copy to Employment Department.
<u>HB 2445</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Allows Director of Agriculture and State Department of Agriculture to choose methods for giving notice regarding quarantines, control areas and related rules in addition to notice by publication in newspaper.
<u>HB 2467</u>	Business and Transportation Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt rules to regulate penalties, fees and charges that insurer imposes for early withdrawal from individual deferred annuity policy.
<u>HB 2476</u>	Rules Authorizes Oregon Department of Administrative Services to adopt by rule uniform policies or procedures.
<u>HB 2480</u>	Business and Transportation Establishes application fee for Oregon Liquor Control Commission processing of certain license applications.
<u>HB 2483</u>	Finance and Revenue Clarifies that right of any other party to seek determination of total real market value of unit of property or real market value of components of tax account or unit of property applies in appeals of accounts constituting unit of property.
<u>HB 2487</u>	Finance and Revenue Requires correction of maximum assessed value due to correction of square footage of property to be proportional to change in real market value of property that is due to correction of square footage.
<u>HB 2567</u>	Business and Transportation Allows direct purchase and sale of bulk distilled liquor between distillery licensees for blending and manufacturing purposes.
<u>HB 2610</u>	Finance and Revenue Adds agricultural workforce housing to property used in relation to agricultural work that is eligible for property tax exemption.
<u>HB 2843</u>	Business and Transportation Authorizes Department of Consumer and Business Services to enter into interagency agreements for Construction Contractors Board to perform duties on behalf of department related to state building code.

<u>HB 3014</u>	Judiciary Changes definition of "grandparent" in laws pertaining to notice to grandparents of juvenile dependency hearings regarding grandchildren, and that authorize grandparents to request visitation or other contact or communication with grandchildren when grandchildren are in legal custody of Department of Human Services.
