Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SJR 27</u>	Finance and Revenue Proposes revision of Oregon Constitution repealing ad valorem property tax system created by Ballot Measure 50 (1997), eliminating equalization grant system established with respect to local option taxes approved pursuant to Ballot Measure 50 and directing Legislative Assembly to provide for exemption from ad valorem property taxes for owner-occupied primary residences.
<u>SB 925</u>	Finance and Revenue Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to report to Legislative Assembly on options for tax reform and make recommendations for legislation intended to reform current tax system.
<u>SB 926</u>	Judiciary Allows court to award attorney fees to prevailing party in action to acquire fee simple title to real property by adverse possession in which adverse possessor is not prevailing party.
<u>SB 927</u>	Finance and Revenue Modifies authority of metropolitan service district to acquire or construct visitor-oriented facilities.
<u>HB 2446</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Deletes prohibition against advertising by unregulated producer engaged in small-scale on-premises sale of raw milk directly to consumer.
<u>HB 2684</u>	Workforce Extends sunset on provisions allowing retired members of Public Employees Retirement System to be employed full-time by public employer as nursing instructor or as trainer for Department of Public Safety Standards and Training without loss of retirement benefits.
