Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SB 938</u>	Finance and Revenue Authorizes county to adopt exemption for newly constructed or installed industrial improvements.
<u>SB 941</u>	Judiciary Requires private person to complete transfer of firearm by appearing with transferee before gun dealer to request criminal background check.
<u>HCR 9</u>	Rules Recognizes importance of insect pollinators and urges support of programs to ensure safety and vitality of pollinator populations.
<u>HJM 1</u>	Rules Urges United States Postmaster General and United States Postal Service Board of Governors to recognize addresses within borders of city of Tigard as within Tigard in United States Postal Service documentation.
<u>HB 2037</u>	Rules Reorganizes Oregon State Capitol Foundation as nonprofit corporation.
<u>HB 2176</u>	Rules Removes requirement that person elected to county office provide county clerk with certificate of election.
<u>HB 2541</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Requires physician, physician assistant or individual licensed to practice nursing, in specified numbers, to be present at blood drives.
<u>HB 2635</u>	Rules Requires ballot title for measure proposing local option tax to state that estimated tax cost may reflect impact of early payment discounts, compression and collection rate.
<u>HB 2645</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness;Education Requires public universities to establish priority enrollment system for qualified students who are active members of Armed Forces of the United States or qualified veterans.
<u>HB 2716</u>	Workforce Requires contracting agencies to provide as material condition of public contract that contractor remain certified as disadvantaged, minority, women or emerging small business enterprise during entire term of public contract if contracting agency awarded public contract, in whole or in part, on basis of contractor's certification.
<u>HB 2798</u>	Business and Transportation Modifies percentage rate and amount of fees that pawnbroker may charge for storage and setup in connection with pledge loans.
<u>HB 3030</u>	Finance and Revenue Authorizes creation of sand control districts for purpose of controlling drifting sand.
