Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SB 939</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Directs Department of Corrections to enter into contracts with nonprofit entities to create programs to assist children of incarcerated parents.
<u>SB 940</u>	Judiciary; Rules Creates crime of receiving quid-pro-quo bribe.
<u>HB 2357</u>	Judiciary Modifies certain law enforcement defenses applicable to certain firearms-related crimes.
<u>HB 2424</u>	Judiciary Authorizes employees of Department of Corrections, State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision and Oregon Corrections Enterprises who work in department building to store personal handgun and ammunition in vehicle.
<u>HB 2628</u>	Judiciary Disallows all filing fees, service fees and hearing fees in action for court's protective stalking order, even if stalking order is not only relief sought in action.
<u>HB 2855</u>	Rules Requires filing officer to deliver by mail and electronic mail form for individual nominated or elected to public office by write-in votes to sign to accept nomination or office if filing officer has individual's electronic mail address.
<u>HB 2886</u>	Business and Transportation Clarifies who may participate in vehicle dealer auction or display of vehicles without holding vehicle dealer certificate.
<u>HB 2957</u>	Rules Establishes specific dates for elections on county measures, city measures and district measures that are not referred to people by county governing body, city governing body or district elections authority.
<u>HB 2969</u>	Business and Transportation Allows on-premises consumption of food and nonalcoholic beverages at certified smoke shops.
<u>HB 3015</u>	Judiciary Adds options for name after marriage or after entering into registered domestic partnership.
