Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>SCR 13</u>	Rules Commends Oregon State University Beavers wrestling team on their exemplary intercollegiate athletic achievements.
<u>SB 943</u>	Business and Transportation Prohibits counties and districts from imposing vehicle registration fee on vehicles registered to employment address when registered owner's residence address is not in same county as employment address.
<u>SB 944</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Prohibits Department of Human Services, Oregon Health Authority or Oregon Youth Authority from contracting with behavior rehabilitation services providers that permit, or authorizing behavior rehabilitation services providers to allow, children or youth who are not sex offenders or who do not have inappropriate sexual behaviors to reside in same home or residential facility as children or youth who are sex offenders or who have inappropriate sexual behaviors.
<u>SB 945</u>	Judiciary Creates crime of endangering a minor by allowing access to a firearm.
<u>SB 946</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness; Ways and Means Creates position of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Coordinator in Department of Veterans' Affairs to provide outreach and assistance to veterans who are lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender, and to spouses and dependents of such veterans.
<u>SB 947</u>	Workforce Requires all employers to implement sick time for employees.
<u>HB 2259</u>	Business and Transportation Modifies authority of Department of Transportation to issue variance permits to operate self-loading log truck.
<u>HB 2400</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Provides that submission of certain task force reports prior to specified dates in 2015 satisfies requirement to submit reports by July 1, 2014.
<u>HB 2468</u>	Health Care Specifies requirements for scope of insurer's network of providers.
<u>HB 2713</u>	Education Directs Secretary of State to conduct audit of use of statewide summative assessment in public schools in this state.
<u>HB 2715</u>	Education Prohibits school district employee or volunteer from posting, publishing or making publicly available personally identifiable information in relation to results of performance-based assessment.
<u>HB 2892</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Requires that National League of Families' POW/MIA flag be displayed with Oregon State flag on public buildings in this state.
