| <u>HCR 8</u> | Rules Honors musical legacy of James Gilbert "Jim" Pepper. |
| <u>HB 2034</u> | Environment and Natural Resources Removes State Parks and Recreation Department's authorization to exercise power of eminent domain over certain land situated within boundaries of Willamette River Greenway. |
| <u>HB 2211</u> | Workforce Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to impose civil penalty for workers' compensation claims processing violations by service company. |
| <u>HB 2261</u> | Business and Transportation Permits person to provide proof of vehicle registration under certain circumstances to avoid charge of illegal display of registration plate or improper display of validating stickers. |
| <u>HB 2281</u> | Business and Transportation For purposes of per-mile road usage charge, makes issuance by Department of Transportation of emblem of exemption from motor vehicle fuel taxes permissive, removes exception to requirement that seller collect use fuel taxes on motor vehicle paying per-mile road usage charge and removes requirement that Department of Transportation round metered use of subject vehicle up to next whole mile. |
| <u>HB 2350</u> | Business and Transportation Updates and clarifies portions of Bank Act and related statutes. |
| <u>HB 2354</u> | Judiciary Changes defined term "drone" to "unmanned aircraft system." |
| <u>HB 2426</u> | Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Establishes statutory authority for technological enhancements to 9-1-1 emergency communications system. |
| <u>HB 2465</u> | Business and Transportation Modifies requirements related to school enrollment that person under 18 years of age must meet before being issued driving privileges. |
| <u>HB 2614</u> | Business and Transportation Allows certain special districts to dispense fuel at nonretail dispensing facility notwithstanding purchase of less than 900 gallons annually. |
| <u>HB 2625</u> | Business and Transportation Creates offense of unlawful parking in space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refueling. |
| <u>HB 2655</u> | Education Directs State Board of Education to adopt specified standards related to student education records. |
| <u>HB 2681</u> | Education Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission and State Board of Education to oversee work group to examine and recommend effective processes and strategies for |

| <u>HB 2687</u> | Business and Transportation Provides exception to offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle for persons operating farm vehicle or engaged in commercial agriculture. |
| <u>HB 2797</u> | Workforce Requires subject employer to pay first installment of temporary disability compensation in workers' compensation claim within 14 days after employer has notice or knowledge of claim and has notice or knowledge of employee's disability. |
| <u>HB 2830</u> | Environment and Natural Resources Modifies time period for local government to take action on application for permit, limited land use decision or zone change after remand based on final order of Land Use Board of Appeals. |
| <u>HB 2974</u> | Rules Requires Legislative Assembly or Secretary of State to hold 10 public hearings throughout state prior to proposing congressional or legislative reapportionment plan. |
| <u>HB 3021</u> | Health Care Requires insurer to offer health care provider method of reimbursement that does not impose fees or other charges on provider. |
| <u>HB 3517</u> | Health Care Authorizes Oregon Health Authority to provide medical assistance, within available funds, to low income children residing in Oregon if necessary to move toward goals of Legislative Assembly expressed in law and to improve health of Oregon communities. |
