Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>HB 2282</u>	Business and Transportation Allows Department of Transportation to accept documents received electronically related to titling, registration, odometer disclosure and other activities.
<u>HB 2578</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Permits individual in hospice program, or next of kin or personal representative of individual who has died, to terminate, without penalty, residential cable service or residential telecommunications service.
<u>HB 2638</u>	Health Care Permits medical assistance recipients and coordinated care organizations to use Oregon Prescription Drug Program.
<u>HB 2934</u>	Health Care Requires Oregon Health Authority to convene stakeholder group to provide recommendations to Legislative Assembly concerning basic health program.
<u>HB 2938</u>	Business and Transportation Prohibits city from requiring consent to annexation of landowner's property in exchange for city providing county service as agent of county.
<u>HB 2964</u>	Judiciary Provides that when guardian ad litem or conservator of estate of child maintains cause of action for damages to child, parent or conservator may file consent to accompany complaint that authorizes inclusion in cause of action of request for recovery of damages to child.
<u>HB 3005</u>	Business and Transportation Extends expiration date of driver license for persons volunteering outside of United States.
<u>HB 3056</u>	Business and Transportation Specifies that crematorium may not be certified by State Mortuary and Cemetery Board if board determines that proposed crematorium presents danger to public health and safety as determined in consideration of standards for training and equipment used in practice of cremation that are based on national industry standards.
<u>HB 3114</u>	Workforce Allows injured worker 90 days from date health benefit plan rejects claim for benefits to file workers' compensation claim.
<u>HB 3139</u>	Health Care Prohibits local government from preventing mobile medical clinic from locating to private property for not more than 180 days.
<u>HB 3168</u>	Judiciary Authorizes court to waive unpaid portion of previously imposed criminal fine if defendant demonstrates financial hardship that prevents completion of drug treatment program.
<u>HB 3255</u>	Business and Transportation Requires person operating bicycle on highway to equip bicycle with red light on rear of bicycle.

<u>HB 3308</u>	Education Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to convene work group to analyze and make recommendations on how to address disparities in higher education among traditionally marginalized, underserved and underrepresented communities.
<u>HB 3375</u>	Education Revises and renames the Minority Teacher Act of 1991.
<u>HB 3382</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Extends sunset from January 2, 2019, to July 1, 2019, for law imposing general prohibition on growing of canola in Willamette Valley Protected District.
<u>HB 3401</u>	Business and Transportation Requires Department of Transportation to study options for improving on-time performance of passenger trains .
<u>HB 3487</u>	Business and Transportation Requires licensed investigator to include investigator's name and license number in all advertisements for investigator's services.
<u>HB 3495</u>	Workforce Provides for employer and employee contributions to pension program and individual account program of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan to first be made for new members for wages that are attributable to services performed during first full pay period following six-month probationary period, without regard to when wages are considered earned for other purposes.
<u>HB 3501</u>	Business and Transportation Revises voting requirements for certain actions related to benefit company formation or conversion.
