<u>HCR 26</u>	Rules In memoriam: David Michael Jones, M.P.A.S., PA-C, 1945-2015.
<u>HB 2314</u>	Judiciary Permits youth offender foster home to be maintained by person related to youth offender by blood or marriage only under circumstances set forth by Oregon Youth Authority in rule.
<u>HB 2585</u>	Business and Transportation Modifies authority granted to owner of lot in planned community or unit in condominium to install and use electric vehicle charging station for personal, noncommercial use.
<u>HB 2594</u>	Business and Transportation Requires insurer of liable party to pay actual costs of emergency response by private emergency responders.
<u>HB 2601</u>	Judiciary Requires member of law enforcement agency who has probable cause to believe custodial interference or kidnapping with respect to child has occurred to notify Oregon State Police missing children clearinghouse within 24 hours .
<u>HB 2693</u>	Judiciary Creates crime of encouraging sexual assault of an animal.
<u>HB 2803</u>	Business and Transportation Requires Oregon Liquor Control Commission to include certain information in orders approving beverage container redemption centers.
<u>HB 2919</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Eliminates reporting requirement related to disclosure, at request of law enforcement agency, of call location information of cellular device used to call 9-1-1 or believed to be in possession of individual who is believed to be in emergency situation.
<u>HB 3069</u>	Education Requires teacher education programs to demonstrate that students enrolled in programs receive certain training related to teaching reading .
<u>HB 3212</u>	Business and Transportation Makes law or rule solely for purpose of regulating previously allowed farming practice land use regulation for purposes of certain land use laws.
<u>HB 3319</u>	Education Directs school districts to submit report to Department of Education on strategies and activities used to reduce dropout rates.
<u>HB 3468</u>	Judiciary;Ways and Means Adds threatening to cause physical injury to animal to induce other person to engage in conduct as manner of committing crime of coercion.
<u>HB 3521</u>	Rules Designates third week in April of each year as Independent Media Week.
