<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>SCR 15</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Declares that lobby message center in Oregon State Capitol shall be known as David S. Barrows Lobby Center.
<a href="#"><u>HCR 18</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Commends Dr. Donald R. Pettit for his career and achievements on Earth and in space.
<a href="#"><u>HJM 3</u></a>	<b>Veterans and Emergency Preparedness</b> Urges Congress to enact legislation requiring stabilization of crude oil prior to transport.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2028</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Permits pharmacists to engage in practice of clinical pharmacy and provide patient care services to patients.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2193</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Directs electric companies, if authorized by Public Utility Commission, to procure one or more energy storage systems that have capacity to store specified amount of energy.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2195</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Directs county with population of less than 650,000, and permits county with population of 650,000 or more, to use proceeds acquired by foreclosure of delinquent tax liens or in exchange for land originally acquired by foreclosure of delinquent tax liens to provide to youth and families with children housing placement and retention support services, rental assistance and low income housing.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2313</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Prohibits person under 21 years of age from attempting to purchase, purchasing or acquiring marijuana items, and from entering portion of licensed premises where such persons are prohibited.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2356</u></a>	<b>Judiciary;Ways and Means</b> Creates crime of invasion of personal privacy in the first degree.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2365</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Updates and revises adoption and readoption laws to provide clarification and consistency.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2366</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Modifies filing, motion and certificate fees in adoption proceedings.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2369</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Requires Department of Human Services to establish by rule responsibilities of case manager who receives notice of life-sustaining procedures for principal for purposes related to withholding or withdrawing those life-sustaining procedures.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2412</u></a>	<b>Education</b> Removes outdated provisions and updates terminology related to teachers.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2469</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Establishes requirements for certain insurers to conduct own risk and solvency assessment and to file report of assessment with Department of Consumer and Business

<a href="#"><u>HB 2509</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Requires State Department of Agriculture to provide mediation program services when person has reasonable belief that planting, growing or harvesting of agricultural or horticultural commodity on nearby land might interfere or is interfering with farming practices.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2565</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Makes Oregon State Bar subject to public employees collective bargaining law.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2599</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Requires utility that provides electric or natural gas service to residential customers to prepare report on utility's processes that mitigate, for nonpayment of delinquent accounts, termination of electric or natural gas service to certain residential customers under certain conditions.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2611</u></a>	<b>Education;Ways and Means</b> Requires universities with institutional governing boards to continue to participate in shared services relating to listed employee benefits and to collective bargaining until July 1, 2019.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2723</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources;Finance and Revenue</b> Authorizes county or city to designate any urbanized area of county or city as urban agriculture incentive zone.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2831</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Modifies authority to use property line adjustments in resource zones.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2832</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Directs governing entity of public or private post-secondary institution of education that contracts with third party financial firm for student financial aid services to consider federal policies for contracting.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2941</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Authorizes electric company to offer residential electricity consumer rate option for electricity associated with specific energy resource.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2948</u></a>	<b>Health Care</b> Specifies additional conditions under which protected health information may be disclosed by health care provider that do not subject health care provider to civil liability.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2958</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Provides that limited license that rental company obtains to sell insurance in connection with renting vehicles also extends to rental company's employees and designated agents.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2980</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Authorizes defendant to request district attorney to approve extension of stay of criminal proceedings for district attorney diversion.

<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>HB 2987</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Removes requirement for contracting agency to hold in account or otherwise reserve moneys for including green energy technology in constructing, reconstructing or performing major renovation on public building if contracting agency determines that including green energy technology is not appropriate.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3011</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Allows dispensary for Class 1 flammable liquids located in low-population county to permit self-dispensing of liquids when no owner, operator or employee of dispensary is present.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3016</u></a>	<b>Human Services and Early Childhood</b> Modifies provisions of capital gains exemption for amounts received for sale of manufactured dwelling park.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3068</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Directs Department of Environmental Quality to conduct study and develop recommendations for legislation to reduce woodstove smoke.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3164</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Specifies conditions under which farm implement supplier has good cause to terminate, cancel or not renew retailer agreement, or to cause change in competitive circumstances for retailer.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3186</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Deletes language prohibiting advertising or promoting outdoor mass gathering without permit.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3223</u></a>	<b>Environment and Natural Resources</b> Modifies provisions authorizing expedited land divisions.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3236</u></a>	<b>Judiciary</b> Limits enforceability of noncompetition agreement to 18 months.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3242</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Permits State Mortuary and Cemetery Board to grant temporary operating permit for cemetery without operating license to perform interment.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3274</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Directs Oregon Business Development Department to conduct study and submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than December 31, 2016, regarding methods to expand broadband and telecommunications infrastructure in rural cities and counties in Oregon.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3303</u></a>	<b>Workforce</b> Permits Certification Office for Business Inclusion and Diversity to certify business that service-disabled veteran owns as disadvantaged business enterprise that is eligible for certain preferences in public contracting.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3317</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Directs Oregon State Lottery Commission, in coordination with Oregon Liquor Control Commission, to submit report biennially on distribution and concentration of video lottery game terminals in relation to measures of socioeconomic status represented at census

<a href="#"><u>HB 3455</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Increases membership of All-Terrain Vehicle Advisory Committee.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3488</u></a>	<b>Business and Transportation</b> Exempts specified instruments that condition transfer of fee simple interest in real property from prohibition on fee, commission or other payment to declarant or other person upon transfer of interest in real property.
