<u>HJM 19</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Urges Secretary of Energy and Congress to support siting of United States Department of Energy's Frontier Observatory for Research in Geothermal Energy at Newberry Geothermal Project.
<u>HB 2375</u>	Business and Transportation Requires state contracting agency to use solicitation template that Attorney General and Oregon Department of Administrative Services develop, approve and make available in advertising and soliciting procurements under Public Contracting Code and to use contract form or contract template, as appropriate, that Attorney General and department develop, approve and make available as basis for public contracts into which state contracting agency enters.
<u>HB 2413</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Prohibits licensing agency from issuing initial license to residential care facility that has not conducted market study.
<u>HB 2463</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Authorizes Department of State Lands to seize abandoned structures and derelict structures on, under or over state-owned submerged and submersible lands.
<u>HB 2471</u>	Workforce Changes qualifications to practice as funeral service practitioner or embalmer in this state, including qualifications related to reciprocity and training.
<u>HB 2472</u>	Workforce Modifies authority of State Mortuary and Cemetery Board to conduct investigations of premises and records of facilities that provide services related to final disposition of human remains.
<u>HB 2696</u>	Health Care Specifies requirements for external quality reviews of coordinated care organizations by Oregon Health Authority.
<u>HB 3025</u>	Workforce Establishes unlawful employment practice of inquiring into or considering applicant's conviction history on application form or prior to interview or, if no interview is conducted, prior to conditional offer of employment.
<u>HB 3329</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Modifies standard by which geothermal energy qualifies as type of green energy technology for which at least 1.5 percent of total contract price of certain public improvement contract for construction or certain reconstruction or major renovation of public school building must be spent.
