<u>HCR 27</u>	Rules In memoriam: David B. Frohnmayer, 1940-2015.
<u>HB 2361</u>	Judiciary Prohibits court from charging or collecting fee for filing of objections or motions by office of Long Term Care Ombudsman or specified system .
<u>HB 2704</u>	Judiciary Creates exemption to prohibition on recording conversations for person openly recording law enforcement officer while officer is performing official duties in public place.
<u>HB 2776</u>	Judiciary Authorizes peace officer to apply for and circuit court to enter ex parte emergency protective order when court finds probable cause that person was victim of domestic disturbance or abuse and protective order is necessary to prevent abuse.
<u>HB 3188</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Authorizes landowners who meet certain criteria to petition for formation of predator damage control district within county.
<u>HB 3214</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Directs Land Conservation and Development Commission to adopt or amend rules related to statewide planning goals to allow local government to rezone land for certain purposes.
<u>HB 3217</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Requires Department of State Lands to adopt pilot program for providing general authorization for voluntary stream restoration and beaver recovery through construction of artificial beaver dams.
<u>HB 3367</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Authorizes local government to conditionally approve establishment of recreational trails on land zoned for exclusive farm use.
<u>HB 3378</u>	Health Care Requires hospital to adopt written discharge policies.
<u>HB 3399</u>	Judiciary Requires justice court or municipal court to record criminal proceedings.
<u>HB 3478</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Phases in prohibition on manufacture and sale of personal care products and over-the-counter drugs that contain synthetic plastic microbeads.
<u>HB 3494</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Prohibits declawing or devocalizing of animal unless procedure is performed by licensed veterinarian under certain conditions.
<u>HB 3524</u>	Judiciary Requires state, when selling or disposing of real property, to grant right of first refusal to developers of affordable housing.
