<b>Measure</b>	<b>Committee/Catchline</b>
<a href="#"><u>SB 971</u></a>	<b>Rules</b> Provides definition for determining undeveloped portion of water right for municipal use.
<a href="#"><u>HB 5012</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts , but excluding lottery and federal funds, collected or received by Department of Consumer and Business Services.
<a href="#"><u>HB 5018</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Environmental Quality for certain biennial expenses.
<a href="#"><u>HB 5044</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Department of Consumer and Business Services.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2407</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Establishes procedures for determining maximum grant amount for Oregon Opportunity Grant program.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2411</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Updates terms for teacher education programs and institutions.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2451</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Extends maximum loan term for loans made from Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund to 30 years.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2846</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Provides that time spent by students consuming breakfast is considered instructional time in certain circumstances.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2960</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Creates Oregon Retirement Savings Board in office of State Treasurer.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2997</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Limits biennial expenditures by Oregon Business Development Department from lottery moneys for funding of cooperative efforts of National Policy Consensus Center of Portland State University and community organizations related to western juniper harvesting and related manufacturing.
<a href="#"><u>HB 2998</u></a>	<b>Ways and Means</b> Requires Oregon Business Development Department to provide economic development assistance to persons engaged in business of western juniper harvesting or of manufacturing products from western juniper, provide technical business assistance to western juniper harvesting and related manufacturing businesses and provide or fund workforce training assistance for potential western juniper harvesting and related manufacturing business workers.
<a href="#"><u>HB 3125</u></a>	<b>Finance and Revenue</b> Exempts from property taxation qualified machinery and equipment used to process grains.
