<u>SJR 201</u>	Finance and Revenue Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution repealing ad valorem property tax assessment provisions created by House Joint Resolution 85 (1997) (Ballot Measure 50 (1997)), requiring ad valorem property taxes to be assessed on real market value of property and directing Legislative Assembly to provide exemption from ad valorem property taxes for owner-occupied principal dwellings and tax lots upon which dwellings are located.
<u>SJR 202</u>	Workforce and General Government;Rules Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require Legislative Assembly to approve each administrative rule or amendment of administrative rule adopted by executive branch agency before taking effect.
<u>SJR 203</u>	Education;Rules Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution establishing State Board of Education.
<u>SJR 204</u>	Rules;Ways and Means Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require Legislative Assembly each biennium to spend percentage of legislatively approved budget for education and for public safety.
<u>SR 201</u>	Rules Congratulates Happy Canyon Indian Pageant and Wild West Show on its centennial anniversary.
<u>SB 1501</u>	Rules Corrects statutory reference from section 9, chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015, to ensure ability of minor political parties to maintain status for 2016 general election based on number of registered electors as of July 1, 2015.

<u>SB 1502</u>	Rules Clarifies meaning of "district" for purposes of initiative and referendum laws.
<u>SB 1503</u>	Health Care Repeals sunset on requirement that insurer reimburse licensed physician assistants and certified nurse practitioners for primary care services that are reimbursed by insurer if provided by licensed physician.
<u>SB 1504</u>	Health Care Enacts interstate Physical Therapy Licensure Compact.
<u>SB 1505</u>	Health Care Authorizes Department of Consumer and Business Services to adopt by rule fees that are reasonably calculated to pay costs associated with administering laws regulating pharmacy benefit managers.
<u>SB 1506</u>	Finance and Revenue Changes minimum expenditure requirement for property tax exemption of qualified machinery and equipment used to process grains or bakery products from \$100,000 of real market value when placed in service to \$100,000 of total cost of initial investment to food processor.
<u>SB 1507</u>	Finance and Revenue Makes corrections to provisions for tax credits allowed for rural medical practice.
<u>SB 1508</u>	Workforce and General Government Increases term of Workers' Compensation Management-Labor Advisory Committee members from two years to three years.
<u>SB 1509</u>	Business and Transportation Provides that cost-effective energy efficiency measures, market transformation measures, new renewable energy resources and low-income weatherization are not purposes for which moneys may be collected through public purpose charge.
<u>SB 1510</u>	Business and Transportation;Ways and Means Provides that bridge that crosses Columbia River near Hood River is part of Oregon Route 35.
<u>SB 1511</u>	Marijuana Legalization Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to register qualified marijuana producers, marijuana processors, marijuana wholesalers and marijuana retailers for purposes of producing, processing and selling marijuana and usable marijuana and medical grade cannabinoid products, cannabinoid concentrates and cannabinoid extracts.
<u>SB 1512</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness;Ways and Means Specifies that proceeds from bonds issued under Articles XI-M and XI-N of Oregon Constitution may be used for surveying and conducting engineering evaluations and for paying costs of personnel, advisors, equipment, supplies and services that are reasonably necessary to carry out seismic rehabilitation grant program.

<u>SB 1513</u>	Finance and Revenue Authorizes county to exempt up to \$250,000 of assessed value of each homestead owned and occupied by surviving spouse of fire service professional or police officer killed in line of duty from ad valorem property taxes imposed by all taxing jurisdictions.
<u>SB 1514</u>	Health Care Permits drug outlet participating in Charitable Prescription Drug Program to repackage certain donated prescription drugs for distribution by other program participants.
<u>SB 1515</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood;Ways and Means Establishes standards and criteria for mandatory licensing, certification or authorization of child-caring agencies by Department of Human Services.
<u>SB 1516</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood;Ways and Means Directs Department of Human Services to convene work group to develop and recommend licensing fees and criminal and civil penalty structure for child-caring agencies, certain foster homes, private residential boarding schools, shelter-care homes and independent residence facilities.
<u>SB 1517</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Requires certain findings by local governing body for creation, restoration or enhancement of wetlands in exclusive farm use zones.
<u>SB 1518</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Requires Department of State Lands to adopt pilot program for voluntary stream restoration and beaver recovery through construction of artificial beaver dams.
<u>SB 1519</u>	Workforce and General Government;Ways and Means Modifies provisions relating to employee contributions of members of Public Employees Retirement System.
<u>SB 1520</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Finance and Revenue Requires Governor, with assistance of State Forestry Department, to attempt state entry into federal Good Neighbor Authority agreement with United States Forest Service.
<u>SB 1521</u>	Business and Transportation Authorizes mass transit district to impose tax on employees of employers within district if district imposes excise tax on those employers.
<u>SB 1522</u>	Rules Designates May of each year as Cystic Fibrosis Awareness Month.
<u>SB 1523</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness;Ways and Means Requires Office of Emergency Management to develop and administer grant program for purpose of installing connectors at certain fuel storage facilities that are compatible with generators used by emergency response personnel.
<u>SB 1524</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Requires law enforcement unit to train public safety officers in veterans' issues.
<u>SB 1525</u>	Workforce and General Government Excludes sick leave pay from definition of "payroll" for purpose of workers' compensation calculations.

<u>SB 1526</u>	Workforce and General Government;Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for Oregon Employer Workforce Training Program, local workforce investment boards and Oregon Youth Conservation Corps.
<u>SB 1527</u>	Business and Transportation Exempts prepaid transportation cards from Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act and related statutes.
<u>SB 1528</u>	Rules Requires members of Commission on Indian Services who are not members of Legislative Assembly to be appointed from nominees selected by tribal councils.
<u>SB 1529</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Prohibits enforcement of residential irrigation requirements by homeowners association following finding or declaration of existing or likely drought conditions.
<u>SB 1530</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Requires certain state agencies to consult with certain federal agencies to determine whether state and federal mining programs can be better coordinated.
<u>SB 1531</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Modifies requirements regarding coordinated care organization contracts and for establishing global budgets and required services.
<u>SB 1532</u>	Workforce and General Government Establishes tiered system for determination of minimum wage based on size and geographic location of employer.
<u>SB 1533</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Permits local governments to adopt land use regulations or functional plan provisions, or impose conditions for approval of permits, that effectively establish sales or rental price for up to 30 percent of new residential development or limit sales or rental purchase to class or group of purchasers or renters in exchange for one or more developer incentives.
<u>SB 1534</u>	Workforce and General Government Provides that certain statutory provisions relating to eligibility of individuals who perform certain services for educational institutions for unemployment insurance benefits during period between two successive academic years or terms or established and customary vacation period or holiday recess do not apply to claim filed by individual who voluntarily left work with good cause.
<u>SB 1535</u>	Education Allows chiropractic physicians and naturopathic physicians to provide release for athlete who sustained concussion or is suspected of sustaining concussion.
<u>SB 1536</u>	Education;Finance and Revenue Modifies percentage of amounts school districts must distribute from State School Fund to public charter schools that are not virtual public charter schools.

<u>SB 1537</u>	Education Establishes criteria by which school district may establish post-graduate scholar program to receive and expend certain State School Fund moneys for certain students who have satisfied requirements for high school diploma.
<u>SB 1538</u>	Information Management and Technology Requires state agencies to notify Legislative Fiscal Office promptly concerning information security incidents and provide office with copies of and report results of information security assessments.
<u>SB 1539</u>	Information Management and Technology Requires state contracting agencies to provide State Chief Information Officer and Legislative Fiscal Office with certain materials in connection with cost analysis that state contracting agency performs to determine whether to conduct information technology procurement or determination as to procurement's feasibility.
<u>SB 1540</u>	Education Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct evaluation on providing tuition waiver for students at community colleges and public universities who are pursuing mathematics-related degrees.
<u>SB 1541</u>	Education;Ways and Means Directs Department of Education to conduct evaluation related to financial accountability of school districts.
<u>SB 1542</u>	Education Allows district school board to enter into written agreement with governing body of federally recognized Native American tribe to identify acceptable use of name, symbol or image of mascot that represents or is associated with Native American tribe, to identify behavior expectations at athletic events and to identify required training on cultural diversity.
<u>SB 1543</u>	Business and Transportation;Ways and Means Directs Oregon Wine Board to distribute moneys from sale of wine country registration plates as matching grants for tourism promotion.
<u>SB 1544</u>	Workforce and General Government Increases maximum number of weeks for which unemployed individual participating in apprenticeship program may be eligible for unemployment insurance benefits.
<u>SB 1545</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood;Finance and Revenue Authorizes formation of children's special districts.
<u>SB 1546</u>	Business and Transportation Prohibits tower from towing motor vehicle from parking facility without first being contacted by owner of facility or owner's agent.
<u>SB 1547</u>	Business and Transportation Clarifies that term "public utility" does not include people's utility district or electric cooperative for purpose of being regulated by Public Utility Commission.

<u>SB 1548</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood Authorizes local governments to expedite inclusion within urban growth boundary of land dedicated to needed housing.
<u>SB 1549</u>	Workforce and General Government Permits Oregon Department of Administrative Services to require fingerprints for purpose of requesting state or nationwide criminal records check of person who is employed or applying for employment with, or provides or seeks to provide services to, qualified entity.
<u>SB 1550</u>	Judiciary;Ways and Means Directs presiding judges of judicial districts within state to ensure proceedings before grand jury are recorded.
<u>SB 1551</u>	Judiciary Authorizes specified reporters to make report to Department of State Police Firearms Unit that person is experiencing mental health emergency and is danger to self or others with firearm.
<u>SB 1552</u>	Judiciary Establishes Advance Directive Rules Adoption Committee for purpose of adopting by rule form of advance directive to be used in this state.
<u>SB 1553</u>	Judiciary Authorizes prosecution of first-degree sex crimes any time after commission of crime if prosecuting attorney obtains corroborating evidence of crime.
<u>SB 1554</u>	Judiciary Enacts Revised Uniform Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets Act (2015).
<u>SB 1555</u>	Judiciary Allows polygraph test as condition of employment for preemployment screening of law enforcement officers.
<u>SB 1556</u>	Judiciary Expands definition of physical injury in Oregon Criminal Code to include physical trauma when injured person is vulnerable victim.
<u>SB 1557</u>	Environment and Natural Resources Ratifies decision of State Fish and Wildlife Commission to remove Canis lupus from state list of endangered species.
<u>SB 1558</u>	Education Prohibits disclosure of records of college or university student health center, mental health center or counseling center, or records of health professional retained by college or university to provide health care, mental health care or counseling services to students, to other individuals, offices or entities within, affiliated with or acting on behalf of college or university.
<u>SB 1559</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Requires, on and after January 1, 2017, persons selling tobacco products or inhalant delivery systems in this state to be licensed by Department of Revenue.

<u>SB 1560</u>	Rules Requires that name of member or committee of Legislative Assembly requesting set of proposed amendments to legislative measure be identified on proposed amendments.
<u>SB 1561</u>	Judiciary Requires court to consider requiring, and authorizes court to order, person to provide or contribute to financial support of child if court grants custody, guardianship, right of visitation, visitation, contact rights or other rights to person.
<u>SB 1562</u>	Rules Modifies day on which odd-numbered year regular session of Legislative Assembly commences to be day after adjournment of organizational session or, if day after adjournment is Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday, on following Monday.
<u>SB 1563</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Authorizes Environmental Quality Commission to develop low-interest loan program for on-site septic system repairs, replacements, upgrades or evaluations.
<u>SB 1564</u>	Education Transfers reporting requirements related to English language learner programs from school districts to Department of Education.
<u>SB 1565</u>	Finance and Revenue Authorizes city or county to adopt exemption for newly constructed or installed industrial improvements with cost of initial investment of at least \$1 million.
<u>SB 1566</u>	Education Removes sunset on provisions that allow students whose legal residence is not within school district to attend school in district as resident if student receives written consent.
<u>SB 1567</u>	Judiciary;Ways and Means Creates crime of criminal impersonation.
<u>SB 1568</u>	Health Care Prohibits discrimination based on age, expected length of life, present or predicted disability, degree of medical dependency or quality of life in determination of medical services covered by state medical assistance program, in coverage under medical retainer practice and in issuance of health benefit plans.
<u>SB 1569</u>	Rules;Ways and Means Establishes Legislative Policy and Research Committee and directs committee to select Legislative Policy and Research Director.
<u>SB 1570</u>	Rules;Ways and Means Requires Legislative Assembly to convene in organizational session in advance of odd-numbered year and even-numbered year regular sessions.
<u>SB 1571</u>	Judiciary;Ways and Means Directs Department of State Police to adopt rules concerning prioritization of testing untested sexual assault forensic evidence kits.
<u>SB 1572</u>	Business and Transportation Directs Public Utility Commission to establish program for procurement of electricity from

<u>SB 1573</u>	Rules Requires city to annex territory without vote upon receipt of petition for annexation submitted by all owners of land in territory provided territory is included within urban growth boundary of city or Metro and is, or will be, subject to acknowledged comprehensive plan of city.
<u>SB 1574</u>	Environment and Natural Resources;Ways and Means Repeals greenhouse gas emissions goals and requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule statewide greenhouse gas emissions goal for 2025, and limits for years 2035 and 2050.
<u>SB 1575</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood;Ways and Means Directs Land Conservation and Development Commission to encourage local governments to dedicate land for affordable housing.
<u>SB 1576</u>	Judiciary Prohibits person that manufactures or distributes prescription contact lenses from preventing retailer from advertising or selling prescription contact lenses at price for consumers that is less than price that person sets or specifies.
<u>SB 1577</u>	Rules;Ways and Means Establishes Legislative Committee on Accountability as joint committee of Legislative Assembly composed of equal number of majority and minority members.
<u>SB 1578</u>	Finance and Revenue Increases amount of maximum total tax credits for certified film production development contributions for fiscal year.
<u>SB 1579</u>	Workforce and General Government Requires state agencies to provide summary of legal advice regarding validity or effect of proposed rule or written order.
<u>SB 1580</u>	Business and Transportation Directs PacifiCorp to suspend collection of two nonbypassable surcharges imposed on PacifiCorp's customers for purpose of removing J.C. Boyle Dam, Copco 1 Dam, Copco 2 Dam and Iron Gate Dam until certain federal law is enacted.
<u>SB 1581</u>	Workforce and General Government Defines employer location as location of headquarters.
<u>SB 1582</u>	Human Services and Early Childhood;Ways and Means Directs Housing and Community Services Department to develop and implement Local Innovation and Fast Track Housing Program to expand state's supply of affordable housing for low income individuals or families.
<u>SB 1583</u>	Business and Transportation Authorizes Office of Small Business Assistance to perform duties with respect to county and municipal agencies and authorities.

<u>SB 1584</u>	Rules Changes water management and conservation plan approval condition for extension of time to construct works or perfect right for municipal use of water.
<u>SB 1585</u>	Health Care;Ways and Means Increases fees to obtain nursing license by indorsement.
<u>SB 1586</u>	Rules;Ways and Means Directs public universities and community colleges to increase voter registration access and information.
<u>SB 1587</u>	Workforce and General Government Modifies information that must be included in itemized statement provided to employee each pay period.
<u>SB 1588</u>	Business and Transportation Allows rural county with no population growth, and other local governments in county, to adopt comprehensive land use plan without complying with statewide land use planning goals.
<u>SB 1589</u>	Business and Transportation;Ways and Means Changes definition of "qualified business" eligible for loan or credit guarantees from Credit Enhancement Fund to include existing or proposed businesses located in this state that will produce substantial benefits for state.
<u>SB 1590</u>	Business and Transportation Provides that insurer that has duty to defend insured against claim has fiduciary duty toward insured if insurer does defend against claim.
<u>SB 1591</u>	Business and Transportation;Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Insurance Regulation with seven members appointed by President of Senate, Speaker of House of Representatives and Governor.
<u>SB 1592</u>	Workforce and General Government Increases Oregon minimum wage rate in graduated steps to \$13.50 per hour by 2019.
<u>SB 1593</u>	Finance and Revenue Expands costs eligible for agriculture workforce housing tax credit to include operation costs incurred by owner in year in which taxpayer does not claim other eligible costs.
