<u>HCR 201</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Recognizes and honors Army Private First Class Anthony T. Justesen (1988-2010) for his service to his country.
<u>HCR 205</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Recognizes and honors Specialist Cody James Patterson (1989-2013) for his service to his country.
<u>HCR 207</u>	Veterans and Emergency Preparedness Recognizes and honors Sergeant Donald R. Walters (1969-2003) for his service to his country.
<u>HJR 203</u>	Rules Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution providing that public universities are not constitutionally prohibited from owning stock in companies, associations or corporations.
<u>HB 4020</u>	Business and Transportation Provides that Oregon Growth Board, in accordance with rules adopted by board, may require that management company or state agency under contract with board invest certain amount in Oregon.
<u>HB 4021</u>	Education Requires State Treasurer and Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to explore approaches for lowering interest rates on student loans for students in Oregon.
<u>HB 4025</u>	Finance and Revenue Updates connection date to federal Internal Revenue Code and other provisions of federal tax law.
<u>HB 4033</u>	Education Specifies that moneys may be distributed under Network of Quality Teaching and Learning for purposes of advancing Educators Equity Act, improving cultural competence of educators and ensuring educators are trained in culturally relevant educational practices.
<u>HB 4048</u>	Business and Transportation Reallocates moneys for transportation projects.
<u>HB 4057</u>	Education Directs Department of Education to prepare report related to students who are in poverty families.
<u>HB 4092</u>	Rules Specifies ballot title and certain other voters' pamphlet elements for House Joint Resolution 203 (2016).
<u>HB 4105</u>	Health Care Requires pharmacy or pharmacist that dispenses biological product to communicate certain information electronically or to prescribing practitioner.
<u>HB 4128</u>	Judiciary Expands crime of obstructing governmental or judicial administration to include engaging
