Measure	Committee/Catchline
<u>HB 5201</u>	Ways and Means Allocates lottery moneys for support of redevelopment of Port of Port Orford Cannery Building.
<u>HB 5202</u>	Ways and Means Modifies amounts authorized for issuance of general obligation bonds, revenue bonds, certificates of participation and other financing agreements for biennium.
<u>HB 5203</u>	Ways and Means Limits for six-year period beginning July 1, 2015, payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Oregon Department of Administrative Services, Oregon Military Department, State Department of Fish and Wildlife and Legislative Administration Committee for capital construction.
<u>HB 4002</u>	Ways and Means Directs Department of Education and Chief Education Office to jointly develop statewide education plan to address chronic absences of students in public schools.
<u>HB 4017</u>	Ways and Means Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services in collaboration with Oregon Health Authority and stakeholder advisory group to report recommendations to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health for blueprint for Basic Health Program.
<u>HB 4042</u>	Ways and Means Creates general assistance project administered by Department of Human Services.
<u>HB 4071</u>	Ways and Means Establishes COFA Premium Assistance Program administered by Department of Consumer and Business Services to provide financial assistance with health care premiums and out-of-pocket costs for Pacific Islanders legally residing in Oregon under Compact of Free Association.
<u>HB 4076</u>	Ways and Means Requires persons who receive grant under Oregon Promise program to complete first-year experience.
<u>HB 4079</u>	Ways and Means Directs Land Conservation and Development Commission to establish pilot program in which local governments may site and develop affordable housing.
<u>HB 4086</u>	Ways and Means Provides for temporary lockout benefits, equal to weekly unemployment benefit amount of individual's most recent unemployment benefit claim, to individual who is unemployed due to lockout.
