SJM 1	Veterans, Emergency Management, Federal and World Affairs
<u>SB 13</u>	Urges Congress to propose for state ratification amendment to United States Constitution to require federal government to operate under balanced budget wherein federal government expenditures do not exceed federal government revenues. Energy and Environment
SB 15	Exempts certain commercial buses from prohibition on titling and registering vehicles powered by certain model year diesel engines to owners located in Multnomah, Clackamas or Washington County. Energy and Environment
SB 20	Requires Public Utility Commission to study leasing or acquiring right of way for generation, transmission or distribution of electricity generated using solar energy. Energy and Environment
SB 23	Requires Public Utility Commission to study feasibility of converting Portland General Electric into a people's utility district. Natural Resources;Ways and Means
SB 123	Directs Water Resources Department to provide grant to City of Carlton for water system infrastructure. Energy and Environment
	Requires Department of Environmental Quality to study recyclability claims.
SB 124	Energy and Environment;Ways and Means
SB 125	Establishes grant program within State Department of Energy to provide grants to fund replacement of generators that use diesel or fossil fuels with renewable hydrogen-fueled generators. Energy and Environment;Ways and Means
SB 126	Directs Department of Transportation to establish grant program for fuel cell electric vehicle and hydrogen fueling demonstration projects. Energy and Environment; Ways and Means
SB 130	Requires State Department of Energy to work with stakeholders to identify areas of inquiry regarding energy and energy use in this state, develop research options and convene advisory group to develop recommendations and benchmarks around energy and energy use in this state. Natural Resources;Tax Expenditures
	Extends sunset for tax credit for fish screening devices.
SB 132	Natural Resources;Tax Expenditures
	Extends sunset for tax credits for owner or operator of agriculture workforce housing.
SB 161	Natural Resources
SB 171	Requires Department of State Lands to study matters relating to management of Elliott State Forest. Natural Resources
	Directs Department of State Lands to study issues related to Department of State Lands and to report to appropriate committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly on or



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	before September 15, 2025.
<u>SB 199</u> SB 220	Energy and Environment Authorizes State Fish and Wildlife Commission to establish by rule requirements or prohibitions concerning angling, taking, hunting, trapping or possessing of wildlife defined as predatory animal. Natural Resources
SB 221	Requires payment of additional 25 percent surcharge on certain assessments by State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries. Natural Resources
	Establishes Electronic Permitting System Subaccount.
SB 222	Natural Resources
SB 223	Authorizes State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to accept payments by credit card and to add fee to credit card transactions. Natural Resources;Tax Expenditures
SB 398	Makes permanent tax credit for taxpayers that install fish screening devices, fish by-pass devices or fishways. Natural Resources
	Requires State Department of Agriculture to study confined animal feeding operations.
SB 399	Natural Resources
	Imposes limit on exempt use of water for livestock.
SB 439	Natural Resources
SB 455	Aligns criteria for alteration, restoration or replacement of a dwellings on lands zoned for forest use consistent with criteria applicable to dwellings on lands zoned for farm use. Natural Resources; Ways and Means
	Directs Oregon Business Development Department to establish and administer grant program for aquifer recharge due diligence and forgivable loan program for aquifer recharge testing.
<u>SB 466</u>	Natural Resources; Ways and Means
SB 496	Allows person taking certain nuisance game mammals to offer meat to charitable organization or retain meat. Housing and Development;Ways and Means
SB 514	Amends allowable purposes of Emergency Housing Account to include account moneys to be used for grants to assist pets of individuals experiencing or at risk of homelessness. Health Care;Ways and Means
	Establishes Adult Suicide Prevention Coordinator within Oregon Health Authority.
SB 541	Finance and Revenue
	Directs Oregon Investment Council to develop, publish and implement policy to incorporate human rights analyses into investment decisions.



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SB 548	Human Services
<u>SB 573</u>	Directs Department of Human Services to maintain inventory of luggage carriers for use when transporting personal effects of foster children. Human Services
SB 583	Directs Center for Health Statistics to enter name of parent on original record of live birth when paternity or parentage has been determined under certain circumstances. Veterans, Emergency Management, Federal and World Affairs
	Designates fourth Saturday of November of each year as Holodomor Remembrance Day.
SB 602	Human Services
SB 606	Directs Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries to appoint long term care wage board to examine factors that may present challenges to recruiting and retaining long term care employees. Human Services;Ways and Means
SB 613	Establishes Nonprofit Workforce Retention Fund in State Treasury, separate and distinct from General Fund, from which Employment Department must provide grants to qualifying nonprofit organizations for purpose of increasing compensation of and reducing turnover among employees of each recipient nonprofit organization. Rules;Ways and Means
	Creates Commission for Indigenous Communities.
SB 629	Health Care
	Modifies membership of Oregon State Hospital Advisory Board.
SB 646	Human Services;Ways and Means
00.005	Requires Oregon Health Authority to request federal approval to allow parent or legal guardian to be paid to act as personal support worker or direct support professional for minor child who has intellectual or developmental disability.
<u>SB 685</u>	Human Services
	Modifies definition of "communication facilitator.".
<u>SB 694</u>	Human Services;Ways and Means
	Requires membership of task forces and work groups to be comprised at least 50 percent of community members and individuals who are members of or who represent community- based organizations.

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
