Measure	Committee/Catchline
HB 4007	Finance and Revenue
HB 4056	Creates an Oregon tax subtraction for amounts received in settlement of civil actions arising from wildfire. Finance and Revenue
HB 4080	Allows former owner, or their heirs or successors, to claim from the county any surplus from a property tax foreclosure. Ways and Means
HB 4109	Declares a state policy to support engagement between offshore wind developers and impacted organizations, communities and tribes. Transportation
HB 4129	Provides that certain aviation grant funds may be used for matching shares of any Federal Aviation Administration grant available and the funds are not limited to federal Airport Improvement Program grants. Ways and Means
HB 4134	Requires the Department of Human Services and the Oregon Health Authority to contract with no more than two agencies to provide agency with choice services to individuals who are older adults or who have disabilities. Ways and Means
	Requires the Oregon Department of Administrative Services Oregon Business Development Department to provide grants to cities for specified infrastructure projects that will benefit housing developments that will make at least 30 percent of the dwelling units affordable to workforce income households.
