

CHAPTER 6

AN ACT HB 5081
 [2002 Second Special Session]

Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating moneys, limiting expenditures or otherwise adjusting appropriations or expenditure limitations, and in addition to any action taken by the Emergency Board, the authorized Administrative Services Economic Development Fund allocations for the following agencies and programs of the State of Oregon are changed by the amounts specified for the biennium ending June 30, 2003:

Notwithstanding any other law appropriating moneys, limiting expenditures or otherwise adjusting appropriations or expenditure limitations, and in addition to any action taken by the Emergency Board, the authorized Administrative Services Economic Development Fund expenditure limitations for the following agencies and programs of the State of Oregon are changed by the amounts specified for the biennium ending June 30, 2003:

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating moneys, limiting expenditures or otherwise adjusting appropriations or expenditure limitations, and in addition to any action taken by the Emergency Board, the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001, established by section 3, chapter 890, Oregon Laws 2001, is increased by \$19,879,490.

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating moneys, limiting expenditures or otherwise adjusting appropriations or expenditure limitations, and in addition to any action taken by the Emergency Board, the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002,

established by section 4, chapter 890, Oregon Laws 2001, is increased by \$20,857,170.

SECTION 5. Notwithstanding ORS 409.435 and 461.549, the amount of \$1,198,417 is transferred from the Problem Gambling Treatment Fund to the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund.

SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law, sections 1 to 4 of this 2002 second special session Act are subject to Oregon Department of Administrative Services rules related to allotting, controlling and encumbering funds.

SECTION 7. This 2002 second special session Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2002 second special session Act takes effect on its passage.
