

CHAPTER 13

AN ACT HB 5091
 [2002 Third Special Session]

Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating moneys, limiting expenditures or otherwise adjusting appropriations or expenditure limitations, and in addition to any action taken by the Emergency Board and by the Legislative Assembly in special session, the authorized appropriations or expenditure limitations for the following agencies and programs of the State of Oregon are changed by the amounts specified for the biennium ending June 30, 2003:

SECTION 2. In addition to and notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$8,177,928 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds received as reimbursement from the United States Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration under the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century, collected or received by the Department of Transportation, for Westside Light Rail debt service.

SECTION 3. If the amendment to section 4, Article XV, Oregon Constitution, proposed by House Joint Resolution 80 (2002 third special session) is approved by the people at an election held throughout this state during the 2002 calendar year, then, on the effective date of that amendment, in addition to and notwithstanding any other law, the amount of \$150,000,000 is established for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from moneys transferred from the Education Stability Fund to the State School Fund.

SECTION 4. If House Bill 4056 (2002 third special session) becomes law and revenue bonds are issued by the State Treasurer under the provisions of section 2, chapter [Vetoed], Oregon Laws 2002 (third special session) (Enrolled House Bill 4056), then in addition to and not in lieu of any other adjustment to the appropriation to the Department of Education for the State School Fund, the appropriation in section 2, chapter 890, Oregon Laws 2001, is reduced by the amount of the net proceeds of those revenue bonds.

SECTION 5. If House Bill 4056 (2002 third special session) becomes law, in addition to and notwithstanding any other law, the amount of \$50,000,000 is established for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2002, as the maximum limit for the payment of expenses from moneys allocated

from the Cigarette Tax Bond Fund to the Department of Education for the State School Fund.

SECTION 6. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,600,000, to be expended as provided in this section.

(2) The moneys appropriated under this section shall be transferred to the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office to be used for anti-gang law enforcement activities in Multnomah County east of 162nd Avenue. The law enforcement activities shall be designed to prevent future gang activities and to enforce laws commonly violated by gang activity.

SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law, this 2002 third special session Act is subject to Oregon Department of Administrative Services rules related to allotting, controlling and encumbering funds.

SECTION 8. The subsection captions used in this 2002 third special session Act are provided only for the convenience of the reader and do not become part of the statutory law of this state or express any legislative intent in the enactment of this 2002 third special session Act.

SECTION 9. This 2002 third special session Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2002 third special session Act takes effect on its passage.
