OREGON LAWS 2012 Special Session Seventy-Sixth Oregon Legislative Assembly

December 14, 2012

Pursuant to Article V, section 12, of the Oregon Constitution, the Governor by proclamation on December 10, 2012, called the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly to convene in special session.

The Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly convened in a one-day special session on December 14, 2012, to consider and pass one bill. The Legislative Assembly then adopted Senate Concurrent Resolution 221 (2012 special session), which adjourned the special session sine die.

Chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2012 (special session) (Enrolled House Bill 4200), took effect on March 15, 2013, the 91st day after the 2012 special session adjourned sine die.
