

CHAPTER 507

AN ACT

HB 5040

Relating to the financial administration of the Psychiatric Security Review Board; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Psychiatric Security Review Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,348,448.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$103,725 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including federal grant funds received from the Oregon State Police for the gun relief program, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not de-

scribed in this section, collected or received by the Psychiatric Security Review Board.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2, chapter 585, Oregon Laws 2011, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and including federal grant funds received from the Oregon State Police for the gun relief program, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 585, Oregon Laws 2011, collected or received by the Psychiatric Security Review Board, is increased by \$41,200.

SECTION 4. This 2013 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2013 Act takes effect on its passage.
