

CHAPTER 78

AN ACT

SB 1542

Relating to the starting date for regular sessions of the Legislative Assembly; amending ORS 171.010; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 171.010 is amended to read:
171.010. The regular sessions of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at the capital of the state and shall commence:

(1) In the case of an odd-numbered year regular session, on the Tuesday after the holiday for Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday.

(2) In the case of an even-numbered year regular session, on the first day of February *[of each year]*, except that if the first day of February is a Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday, the regular session shall commence on the following Monday.

SECTION 2. This 2018 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2018 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
