NOTES OF DECISIONS

This statute should be liberally construed in favor of the

Substantial compliance with former similar section was held sufficient in the absence of a showing that defendant had been prejudiced. *Loe v. Lenhardt*, (1961) 227 Or 242, 362 P2d 312.

The requirement of notice is mandatory but if not alleged by claimant, defendant must allege and prove failure to comply with the statute or the objection is waived. *Cross v. Harris*, (1962) 230 Or 398, 370 P2d 703.
