NOTES OF DECISIONS

An administrative agency cannot authorize, by regulation, the performance of an act which is prohibited by statute. *McLain v. Lafferty*, (1971) 257 Or 553, 480 P2d 430.

A regulation purporting to authorize school bus drivers to stop on highways in a manner contrary to statute was invalid. *Id.*
