Camera and smart phone use (including for Social Media) On the House floor, by Members, Staff, Media and guests. While in session, including the protocol period



ONLY Representatives may take pictures and or videos of any kind, form or for any platform (no flash, please) inside the bar, while in session.

-Staff may take pictures from 2 areas in the House Chamber, all of which are outside the bar,

South side-aisle (on 2nd floor,);

The South Gallery (on 3rd floor)

Center Gallery, 3rd floor, in designated area, maximum 6 people.

-Journalists and professional photographers unless otherwise authorized may take pictures from 2 areas in the House Chamber, all of which are <u>outside</u> the bar.

South side-aisle (on 2nd floor,):

The South Gallery (on 3rd floor).

Center Gallery, 3rd floor, in designated area, maximum 6 people.

-Guests may take pictures from 2 areas in the House Chamber, all of which are outside the bar.

South side-aisle (on 2nd floor,);

The South Gallery (on 3rd floor)

Center Gallery. 3rd floor, in designated area, maximum 6 people.

General rules for all areas, please...

Refrain from using flash, strobe or supplemental lighting,

Don't block the view of others or fixed Assembly cameras.

Don't block exits and walkways with equipment.

Specifics of camera usage by area:

South side-aisle (on 2nd floor,); hand-held, mono pods only.

South gallery (3rd floor), hand-held, **monopod**, and **tripod**.

Center Gallery, 3rd floor, in designated area, maximum 6 people; hand-held, monopod, and tripod.

Notes to legislative assistants:

- It would be helpful for you to go over these guidelines with your Representative's guests <u>beforehand.</u>
- 30 minutes prior to and after session the Chamber is in protocol, if your member wants to have pictures taken with visiting constituents on the floor, check with the Sergeant at Arms or a Page. If it is determined that the picture-taking is not disruptive to others in the Chamber, it might be allowed...but only if requested.
