As a Legislative Page, you will spend a week in the Oregon State Capitol learning all about our government and be a part of the 2020 legislative session. If you are an incoming 9th through 12th grade, you may apply to become part of Oregon history by participating in the Oregon Legislative Page Program.

Each week during the legislative session the program will bring in 12-14 students who will spend their week working in the Legislative process and attending direct instruction classes. Students will develop skills and attributes necessary for a productive and informed citizen through the program. Key attributes of this week-long program will include:

-Civics classes: Students attend a teacher- guided learning experience

-On-the-House floor and On-the-job Training

-Daily speakers on a wide range of topics

-Direct interaction with members, staff and the multitude of visitors to the capitol during a legislative session.

-Potential high school credit for students attending

-A final capstone project and learning activities

-Free scholarship to a summer, leadership learning program.
